AN ORDINANCE

ANNEXING REAL ESTATE ON THE NORTH
SIDE OF THE CITY OF PORT WASHINGTON
LYING ADJACENT TO SAID CITY LIMITS.

The Common Council of the City of Port Washington pursuant and under the provisions of Section 62.07 of the Wisconsin Statutes do ordain that certain real estate lying north and adjacent to the City of Port Washington, be annexed to the City of Port Washington.

1. That the public welfare and best interests of the City of Port Washington and the natural northward expansion of the City of Port Washington required the addition of territory to be made a part of such City.

2. That the real estate herein described as follows, to-wit:-

That part of the Southeast one-quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section numbered Twenty-One (21) and government lot numbered three (3) in the Southwest Fractional one quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section numbered Twenty-Two (22) in township numbered eleven (11) North range numbered Twenty-Two (22) east, Town of Port Washington, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin, described as follows: Commencing at a point in the west line of said southeast one-quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of section Twenty-One (21) six hundred seventy-five (675) feet north of the southwest corner of said southeast one-quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-One (21), said point being on the north limits line of the City of Port Washington in said Ozaukee County; thence north on said west one-quarter section line to a point eight hundred thirty (830) feet south of the northwest corner of said southeast one-quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of section Twenty-one (21); thence east and parallel to the north line of said southeast one-quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of section Twenty-one (21) to the east line of said section Twenty-One (21); thence north on said east section line to the northwest corner of said government lot three (3); thence east on said north government lot line to the shore of Lake Michigan; thence southwesterly along the shore of Lake Michigan to a point in the present north limits of said City of Port Washington, which north limits line is six hundred seventy-five (675) feet north of the south line of said Section Twenty-Two (22); and thence west on said present north limits line to the place of beginning.

hereby is annexed to and made a part of the City of Port Washington, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin.

3. That the said territory is made part of and annexed to what is now designated as the First (1st) Ward of the City of Port Washington, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin, and that the electors residing therein shall be entitled to vote after registration as required by the laws of the City of Port Washington in the designated polling places for the electors of the First (1st) Ward of the City of Port Washington.
