

## AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF WAUPACA, WISCONSIN.

The Common Council of the City of Waupaca, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

**SECTION 1. Territory Annexed.** In accordance with s. 66.025 of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1963, the following described territory in the Town of Waupaca, Waupaca County, Wisconsin, now owned by the City of Waupaca, Wisconsin, is hereby annexed to the City of Waupaca, Wisconsin, to-wit:

A parcel of land located in the North One-half ( $N\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter ( $NE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Nineteen (19), Township Twenty Two (22) North, Range Twelve (12) East, being more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 19; thence West along the South line of said Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter for a distance of 1075.5 feet; thence North a distance of 1250.2 feet, thence West parallel with and 66 feet South of the North line of said Section 19 a distance of 915.3 feet; thence South  $2^{\circ}52'$  West a distance of 315 feet; thence South  $82^{\circ}30'$  West a distance of 387.5 feet to the centerline of State Trunk Highway 49; thence Northerly along the centerline of said highway to the intersection of the North line of said Section 19; thence East along the North line of said Section 19 to the Northeast corner of Section 19; thence South to the Point of Beginning, excepting that portion of land previously deeded for Highway purposes.

**SECTION 2. Effect of Annexation.** From and after the date of this ordinance the territory described in Section 1 shall be a part of the City of Waupaca for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the City of Waupaca.

**SECTION 3. Temporary Zoning Classification.** The territory annexed to the City of Waupaca by this ordinance is temporarily designated to be a part of the heavy industrial districts of the City of Waupaca for zoning purposes and subject to all the provisions of Ordinance No. 196 of the City of Waupaca entitled "Zoning Ordinance" relating to such district classifications and to zoning in the City of Waupaca, and the Plan Commission is directed to prepare an amendment to the zoning ordinance setting forth the permanent classifications and regulations for the zoning of the annexed area and to submit its recommendations to the Common Council not later than August 25, 1965.

**SECTION 4. Ward Designation.** The territory described in Section 1, of this ordinance is hereby made a part of the Third ward of the City of Waupaca, subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the City of Waupaca governing wards.

SECTION 5. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.



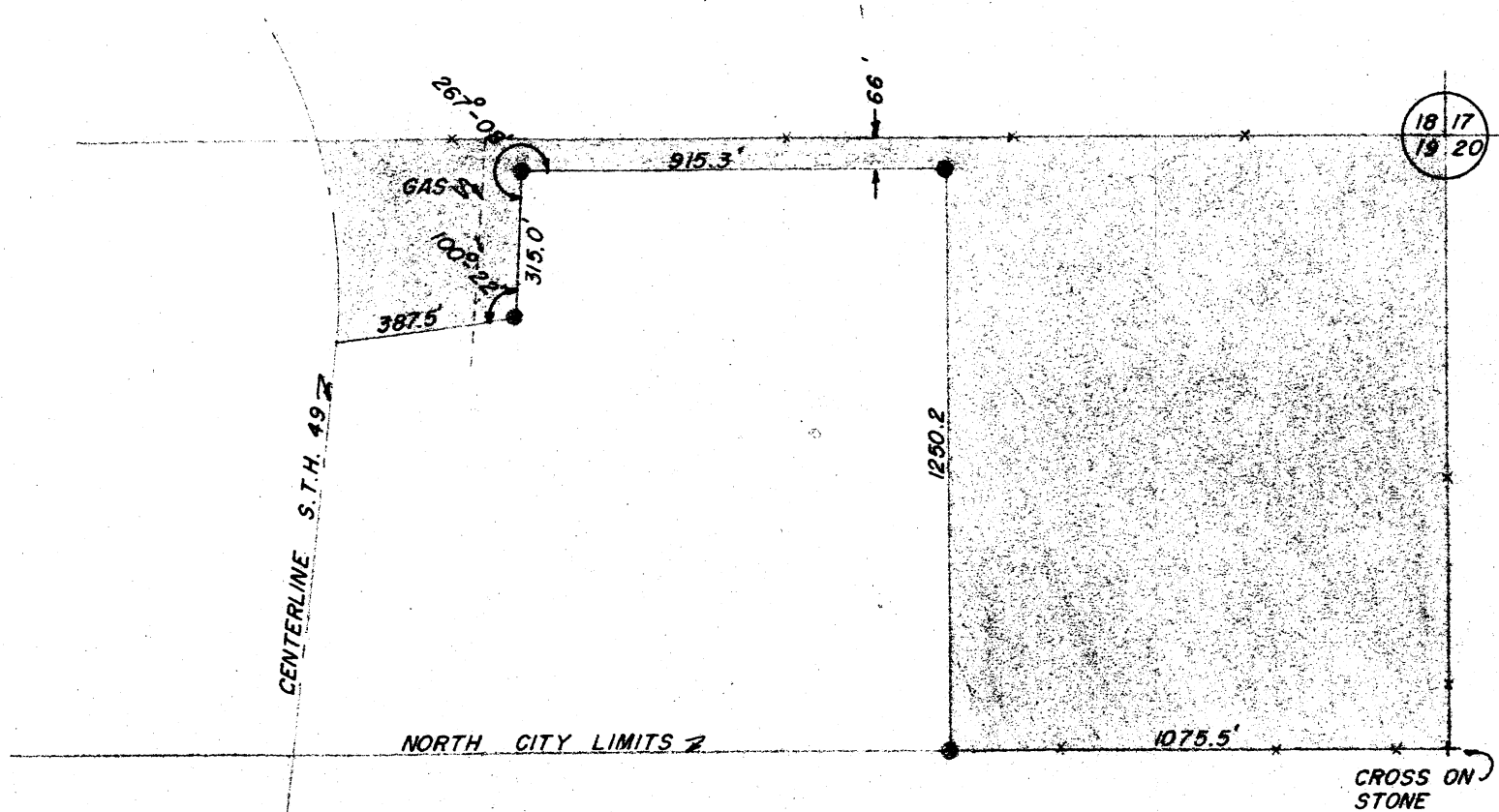
CITY OF WAUPACA
