A Charter Ordinance to repeal and recreate Section 4.06 (title); to amend section 4.05(3); and repeal sections 4.07 and 20.14 of the Milwaukee City Charrelating to changes in common council procedures necessary to implement computerized legislative systems.

The Mayor and Common Council of t City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 4.06 (title) of the charter

is repealed and recreated to read: 4.06 Ordinances; passage and publication. Part 2. Section 4.06(3) of the charter is ended to read:

(3) All ordinances passed by the common council shall be signed by its presiding officer, attested by the city clerk and approved by the mayor and shall be published in the official newspaper of the city that the care and the incity before the same shall be in force. The publication of each ordinance in the official newspaper shall contain the number of the council file from which COMMINON originated, the dates of passage and publi-cation, the relating clause and either the full text of the ordinance or a notice of where the full text of the ordinance can be obtained. Publication shall be within 15 days of passage, excluding Saturdays, Sondays or holidays and shall be proved by an affidavit of the foreman or publisher of an amazave of the foreman or publisher of the official newspaper. The city clerk shall file the affidavit, which shall be deemed sufficient evidence of publication, with its respective ordinance file and the ordinance shall be engrossed by the city clerk and kept on file as part of the official record of

the city.
Part 3. Section 4.07 of the charter is

repealed. Part 4. Section 20.14 of the charter is

repealed.
Part 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances contravening the provisions of

this ordinance are repealed. Part 6. This is a charter ordinance and and publication, unless within such 60 days a referendum petition is filed as provided in s. 66.01(5), Wis. Stats, in which event this ordinance shall not take effect until submitted to shall take effect 60 days after its passe.
