Ordinance No. 338

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF WAUSAU.

The Common Council of the City of Wausau do ordain as follows:

Whereas, the City of Wausau is the sole owner of the territory hereinafter described, which territory now comprises a part of the Town of Stettin, in Marathon County, State of Wisconsin, and which territory lies contiguous to said City of Wausau, and it is desired by the said City of Wausau that said territory be annexed to the City of Wausau, and,

Whereas, the exact description of the territory to be annexed to the City of Wausau is as follows, to-wit:—

“The South One-Half ($S\frac{1}{2}$) of the East One-Half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-seven (27), in Township Twenty-nine (29) North, of Range Seven (7) East, Marathon County, Wisconsin.”

NOW, THEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of Wausau do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1.

All of said territory described as:

“The South One-Half ($S\frac{1}{2}$ of the East One-Half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-seven (27), in Township Twenty-nine (29) North, of Range Seven (7) East, Marathon County, Wisconsin.”

is hereby annexed to the Ninth Ward of the City of Wausau, and is included within the boundary of the City of Wausau, Marathon County, State of Wisconsin, and shall constitute a part of the body corporate as a part of said City of Wausau and be governed by the Charter and Laws of this State.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall cause a certified copy of this Ordinance to be filed in the office of the Secretary of State, as provided by law.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication and after the certified copy of this Ordinance is filed in the office of the Secretary of State, as herein provided.
