# AN ORDINANCE

The Common Council of the City of Wausau, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Territory Annexed</u>. In accordance with Chapter 66, Wisconsin Statutes (1973), and the petition for unanimous direct annexation signed by James M. Schneck and Sue Ann Schneck, sole owners of the land described below, now located in the Town of Wausau, Marathon County, Wisconsin:

Part of the N<sup>1</sup>2 NW fractional ½, Sec. 18, Twp. 29 N., R. 8 E. in the Tn. of Wausau, Marathon County, Wis.:

Beginning at the iron rod stake at the NE corner of Lot 92 of Lydia's Add. to Arnold Taschler's Subdivision in the City of Wausau, Marathon County, Wis.; said iron rod being S00°20'20"W 459.575 feet and S89°23'20"E, 389.900 feet from the Northwest corner of said Sec. 18;

Thence continue S89°23'20"E, 95.00 feet to an iron pipe stake;

Thence S00<sup>0</sup>15'50"W, 150.00 feet to an iron pipe stake on the North line of Maple Hill Road extended;

Section 4. Aldermanic District. The territory described in Section 1. of this ordinance is hereby made a part of the Seventh Aldermanic District of the City of Wausau, subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the city governing districts.

Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance, which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
