## AN ORDINANCE

The Common Council of the City of Wausau, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. <u>Territory Annexed</u>. In accordance with Chapter 66, Wisconsin Statutes, and the petition for annexation signed by Dale H. Becker and Sally J. Becker, sole owners of the land within the territory described below, now located in the Town of Stettin, Marathon County, Wisconsin, is hereby annexed to the City of Wausau:

That part of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 34, Township 29 North, Range 7 East, described as follows:

Beginning at a point 24.75 feet South and 228.75 feet East of the 1/8 section corner (iron stake) of the N 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of said section; and running thence South 185.2 feet; thence East 88 feet; thence North 185.2 feet to the South line of Sherman Street; and thence West 88 feet to the point of beginning.

That part of Sherman Street lying adjacent to the above described parcel, now in the Town of Stettin.

Section 2. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of publication of this ordinance the territory described in Section 1 shall be a part of the City of Wausau, for any and all purposes provided by law, and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the City of Wausau.

Section 3. Zoning Classification. Zoning of the within lands shall be pursuant to sec. 23.04.040, Zoning of Annexed Lands, of the Wausau Municipal Code.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Aldermanic District</u>. The territory described in Section 1 of this ordinance is hereby made a part of the Tenth Aldermanic District of the City of Wausau, subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the city governing districts.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance, which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

<u>Section 6.</u> Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
