



AN ORDINANCE

The Common Council of the City of Wausau, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. In accordance with Chapter 66, Wisconsin Statutes, and the petition for annexation signed by Beth D. Scott and Frederick G. Scott, owners of more than 50% of the land within the territory described herein, situated in the Town of Wausau, Marathon County, Wisconsin, is hereby annexed to the City of Wausau:

That part of the S 1/2 of the SW fractional 1/4, Section 30, Township 29 North, Range 8 East, described as follows:

Commencing at a point 33 feet south of the northwest corner of said S 1/2 of the SW fractional 1/4; running thence South 194 feet; thence East 175 feet; thence North 194 feet; thence West 175 feet to the point of beginning.

and also

that part of Franklin Street lying adjacent to the above described parcel.

Section 2. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of publication of this ordinance the territory described in Section 1. shall be a part of the City of Wausau, for any and all purposes provided by law, and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the City of Wausau.

Section 3. Zoning Classification. Zoning of the within real estate shall be pursuant to sec. 23.04.040, Zoning of Annexed Lands, of the Wausau Municipal Code.

Section 4. Aldermanic District. The territory described in Section 1. of this ordinance is hereby made a part of the ~~Fifth~~ Fourth

Aldermanic District of the City of Wausau, subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the city governing districts.

Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstance is, invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance, which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication, as provided by law.
