

AN ORDINANCE

The Common Council of the City of Wausau do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. In accordance with Chapter 66, Wisconsin Statutes, and the petition for direct annexation signed by Thomas L. Miller and Joan Burk-Miller of Miller Strawberry Acres, sole owner of the land now located in the Town of Stettin, Marathon County, Wisconsin, there being no electors residing therein, the following described land is hereby annexed to the City of Wausau:

SEE ATTACHED LEGAL DESCRIPTION AND MAP

Section 2. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of publication of this ordinance, the territory described in Section 1 shall be a part of the City of Wausau and of the Wausau School District for any and all purposes provided by law, and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the City of Wausau, and governing the School District.

Section 3. Zoning Classifications. Zoning of the within real estate shall be pursuant to Section 23.04.020, Zoning of Annexed Lands, of the Wausau Municipal Code.

<u>Section 4. Aldermanic District.</u> The territory described in Section 1 of this ordinance is hereby made a part of the <u>9th</u> Aldermanic District and the <u>52nd</u> Ward of the City of Wausau, subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the city, county, and state, governing districts.

<u>Section 5.</u> The State of Wisconsin, Department of Commerce, has favorably reviewed the annexation and found it not to be against the public interest.

Section 6. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such

invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance, which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

Section 7. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.



ANNEXATION - MILLER

Part of the East 1/2 of Section 32, Township 29 North, Range 7 East, Town of Stettin, Marathon County, Wisconsin, described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the Southerly right-of-way of STH "29" and the Easterly right-of-way of 48th Avenue, the point of beginning;

Thence Westerly, along said Southerly right-of-way extended Westerly, to a line which is 25 feet West of and parallel to the East line of the SW1/4 of the NE1/4 of said Section 32; thence South, parallel to said East line to the South line of said SW1/4 of the NE1/4, thence South, on a line 25 feet West of and parallel to the East line of the NW1/4 of the SE1/4 of said Section 32, to the Northerly line of Lot 1 of Certified Survey Map No. 9609 recorded in the Office of Register of Deeds for Marathon County in Volume 39 of Certified Survey Maps on page 32; thence Southwesterly, along said North line, to the Northwest corner of said Lot 1; thence Southerly, along the West line of said Lot 1, to the North bank of the Big Rib River; thence Easterly, along said North bank, to the Easterly line of said Lot 1; thence Northerly, along said Easterly line, to the Northeast corner of said Lot 1; thence Northerly, to the intersection of the Easterly right-of-way of 48th Avenue and the Northerly right-of-way of the Chicago and Northwestern Railway; thence Northerly, along said Easterly line, to the Southerly right-of-way of STH "29", the point of beginning.
