IN THE MATTER OF THE ALTERATION OF THE BOUNDARIES
OF THE VILLAGE OF AMERY.

At a general term of the Circuit Court of the eleventh judicial circuit of the State of Wisconsin, begun and held within and for the County of Polk, at the Court House in the Village of Balsam Lake in said County on the 3rd day of November, A. D. 1913, and on the 2nd day of said term, Present the

Hon. Frank A. Ross, Circuit Judge presiding.

This matter coming on to be heard on the petition of P. C.

Ammundson, O. A. Dahlstrom, S. L. Pennington, A. Feit and H. Phillips, W. T. Kennedy, Esq., appearing for the petitioners and no appearance being made in opposition to said petition, and no objections being filed thereto, and the court having heard all parties interested for or against said application and having fully examined the survey, map and census and all the proofs and files in the matter and being fully informed, and it appearing to that petitioners are taxpayers and residents of said Village, the satisfaction of the court that such survey, map and census are accurate and correct, that all the requirements of the Statute and law have been complied with and that such Village after the proposed alteration or change, contains within its limits a population equal in number to that required by section 854 of the Wisconsin statutes and that it contains an area as required by said section, that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Amery have duly adopted a resolution consenting to such proposed alteration and that all the owners of property to be annexed, or disconnected, consent to such proposed alteration of change of boundaries of such Village,

Now therefore, on motion of Kennedy & Yates, Attorneys for said petitioners,

It IS ORDERED, that the boundaries of the Village of Amery, in said Polk County be and the same are hereby altered and changed by annexing thereto the following described lands to-wit:-

The S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ and the W. $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 28, Twp. 33 N. Rge. 16 W. All of the E. $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 33, and the S. $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 33, Twp. 33, N. Rge. 16 W. The S. $\frac{1}{2}$ of S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 32, Twp. 33 N. Rge. 16 W. All of lot six, Sec. 29, and that part of lot one Sec. 29, lying south of the north $\frac{1}{8}$ line of said Section, in Twp. 33 N. Rge. 16 W. all in Polk County, Wisconsin.

Commencing at the Government $\frac{1}{4}$ stake at the south $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 33, Twp. 33 N. Rge. 16 W. at an iron stake, thence east on Township line va N. 85 degrees E. 39.95 ch. to S. E. Corner Sec. 33 at iron stake: Thence North 80.20 ch. to Government corner common to Section 27, 28, 33 and 34, true va 5-30 E. thence west on $\frac{1}{8}$ line 20 chain to $\frac{1}{8}$ Government corner at iron stake: thence north va 5.20 at 39 14 ch. back of flowage and set iron stake at 59.85 ch. close on stake at center of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 28: thence west on $\frac{1}{8}$ line va 5-30, 7.20 ch. to west bank of Apple River, at iron stake: thence west va 5-30 at 58.10 ch. bank of Pike Lake at stake, at 81 ch. cross lake, at 93.40 ch. enter lake, at 100 ch. set tamarac stake in lake for N. W. corner of Village bearing double black oak 3 in. S. 77 W. 40 40 ch. this corner being at the N. W. corner of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 29, Twp. 33 N. Rge. 16 W.; Thence south on $\frac{1}{4}$ line va 5-30, at 20 ch. set tamarac stake in Lake, at 35.50 ch. leave lake, at 38 ch. enter swamp, at 40 ch. set stake in swamp, at 60 ch. found and identified Government $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. on South side of Section 29: Thence south va 5-30, at 3.50 ch. enter marsh, at 4.50 ch. Ry track, at 79.35 ch. wagon road, at 80 chains found and identified S. $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 32, where I found the stake and remains of Government witness trees fully identified and set iron stake for S. W. corner of Village: thence east, true va. N. 85 15 E. at 49. ch. on Twp. line found and identified S. E. Gov. corner of Sec. 32: thence east, true va. N. 85 E. at 35.90 ch. enter Apple River, at 36.80 ch. leave river, at 39 80 ch. close on stake being S. $\frac{1}{4}$ stake of Sec. 33, all in Twp. 33 N. Rge. 16 W. and the point of beginning.

and that the boundaries of such Village as altered and changed be fixed and described by courses and distances as follows to-wit:-

That all the owners of all the lands to be annexed or disconnected having consented to said alteration, an election may be dispensed with and this alteration shall take effect and be in force from and after the recording of this order in the office of the Register of Deeds of said Polk County, as provided by Section 870 1 of the statutes.


