CHARTER ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING A PORTION OF THE CHARTER ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MENASHA, PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENT BY THE COUNCIL OF A FULL TIME ASSESSOR, AND PROVIDING FOR A TERM OF ONE YEAR FOR SUCH ASSESSOR.

OF ONE YEAR FOR SUCH ASSESSMENT.

The Common Council of the City of Menasha do ordain as follows:

Section-1- That part of Chapter 11, Section of the Charter for the City of Menasha which provides follows "The elective officers of said city shall be-two assessors ---- , is hereby repealed.

Section -11- Chapter 1V, section 19, which provides that "The assessors shall not receive compensation for a longer time than fifty days for making the assessment of real and personal property of said city", is hereby repealed.

Section -111- That Chapter 62 of the Wisconsin Statutes in so far as the same relates to the office of City assessor is hereby adopted.

Section -IV- That one assessor only be hereafter selected for said office, the term of which shall be for one year and the duties of which shall extend over a period of one year at full time.

Section -V- Said assessor shall be appointed by the common council annually on the first regular meeting of April of each year.

Section -Vl# Said assessor shall have and perform all the powers and duties as prescribed by law and shall receive such compensation as the Common Council shall determine.

Section -V11- This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption by a two-thirds vote of all the members of the Council, its approval by the Mayor, its publication as provided by law, and the expiration of sixty days.
