

This is holding up the metering which is one of the first steps required to determine the amount of infiltration.

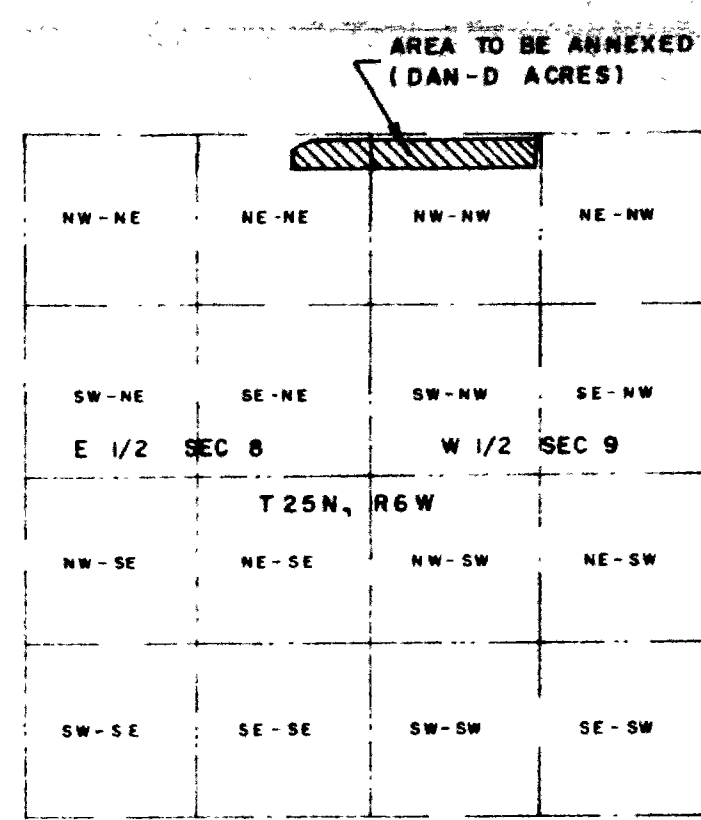
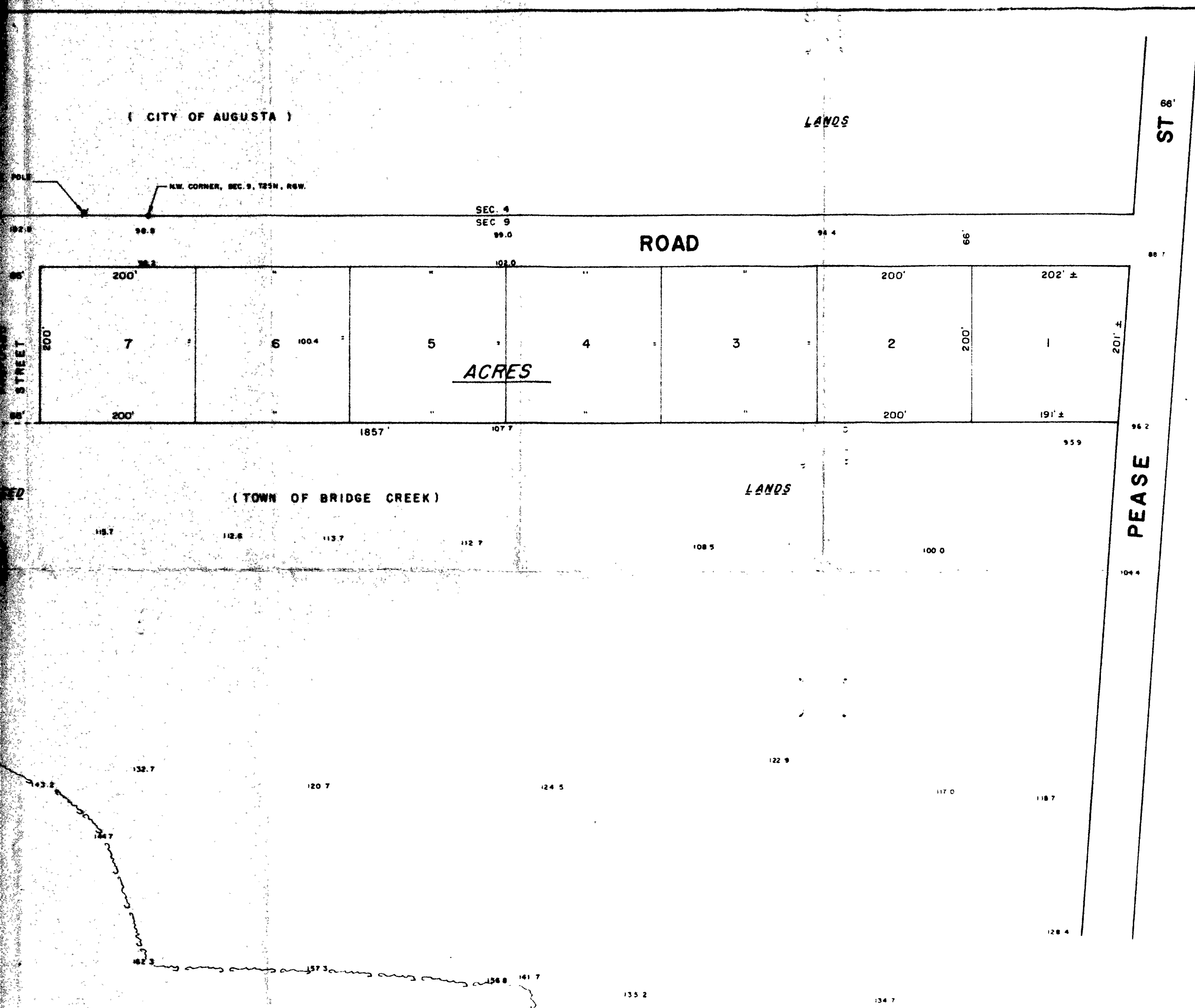

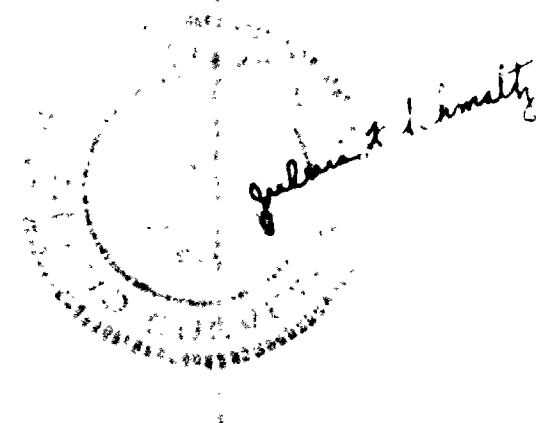
