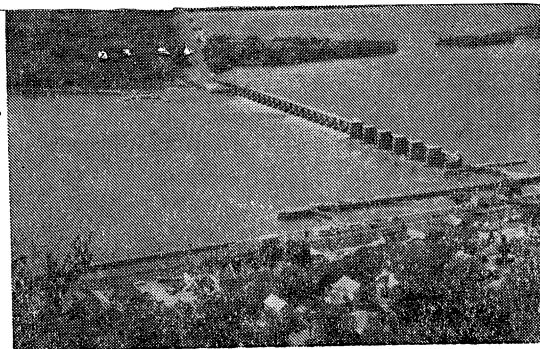





AN ORDINANCE  
ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF ALMA, WISCONSIN

The Common Council of the City of Alma, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Territory Annexed. In accordance with Section 66.021(12) of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1977 and the petition for direct annexation filed with the City Clerk on the 24th day of March, 1980 and on December 1, 1980, signed by all of the electors and real estate owners of the following described territory in the Town of Nelson, Buffalo County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the City of Alma, Wisconsin:

The SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 23, T 22 N, R 13 W, excepting lands conveyed in Volume 75 Deeds, Page 241, namely commencing at the NE corner of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , thence South on East line thereof, to SE corner of said forty, thence due West on South line of said forty, 80 rods to place of beginning.

The West Half of the East Half and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 23, T 22 N, R 13 W of the 4th P.M.

SECTION 2. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this ordinance the territory described in Section 1 shall be a part of the City of Alma for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the City of Alma.

SECTION 3. Ward Designation. The territory described in Section 1 of this ordinance is hereby made part of the 3rd Ward of the City of Alma, subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the City governing wards.

SECTION 4. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect


without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

SECTION 5. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances. Any ordinances heretofore enacted by the City Council of the City of Alma in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed and specifically the ordinances of annexation for this same territory enacted on December 28, 1979 and March 31, 1980 are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

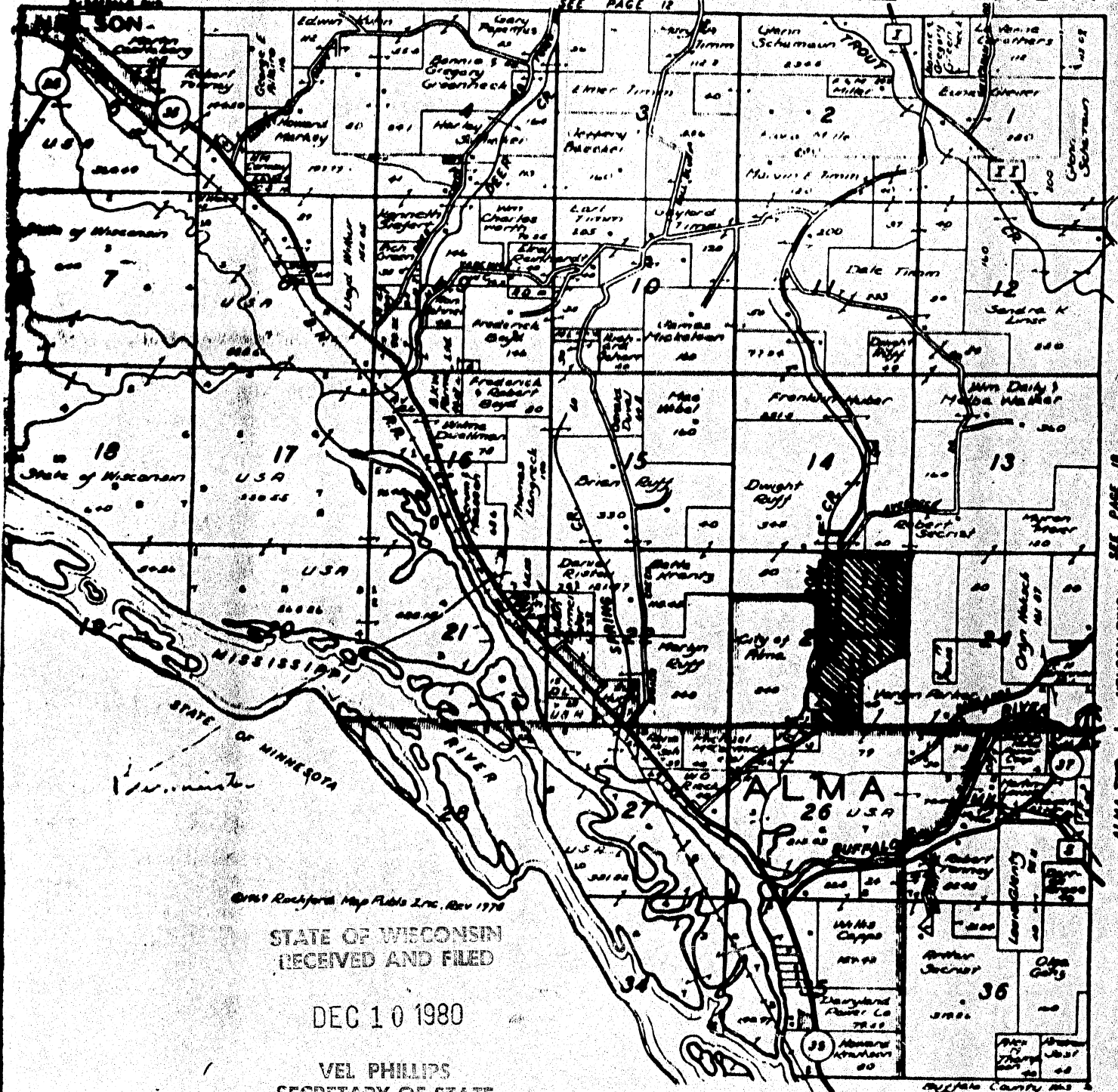
