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## ORDINANCE NO. 89-13

An Ordinance Annexing Territory to the City of Cedar Supgrary OF STATE

(DiVall Real Estate Development Group)

The Common Council of the City of Cedarburg, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Territory Annexed. In accordance with Section 66.021 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and the petition for annexation filed with the City Clerk of the Cedarburg of Cedarburg, Wisconsin, on the 9th day of March, 1989, signed by all the electors residing in the territory and the owners of all the real property in the territory, the following described territory in the Town of Cedarburg, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the City of Cedarburg, Wisconsin:

That part of the Southeast 1/4 and the Southwest 1/4 of Section 34, Town 10 North, Range 21 East, in the Town of Cedarburg, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin, which is bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of the Southeast 1/4 Section, aforesaid; thence N 00° 18' 30" East, along the West line of said 1/4 Section 33.00 feet to the point of Beginning of the lands to be described; said point also being on the North line of Pioneer Road; thence N 89° 57' 30" West, 193.74 feet to a point; thence N 00° 18' 30" East, 335.00 feet to a point; thence N 89° 57' 30" West, 139.57 feet to a point; thence N 00° 01' 24" West, 957.38 feet to a point; thence S 89° 13' East, 298.86 feet to a point, thence N 00° 18' 30" East 270.11 feet to a point; thence S 89° 58' 37" East, 220.00 feet to a point; thence S 00° 18' 30" West and parallel to said West line, 270.54 feet to a point; thence S 89° 58' 37" East, 939.02 feet to a point; thence S 03° 34' 00" West, 1323.27 feet to a point; thence West 378.60 feet to a point; thence N 00° 18' 30" East, 368.00 feet to a point; thence West, 625.21 feet to a point; thence S 00° 18' 30" West, 335.00 feet to a point; thence West 40.00 feet to the point of beginning. The above described parcel contains 37.707 acres of land.

SECTION 2. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this ordinance the territory described in Section 1 shall be a part of the City of Cedarburg for any and all purposes provided by law, and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the City of Cedarburg.

SECTION 3. Temporary Zoning Classification. (a) Upon recommendation of the Plan Commission the territory annexed to the City of Cedarburg by this ordinance is temporarily designated to be part of the following district of the City for zoning purposes and subject to all provisions of the ordinances of the City of Cedarburg, relating to such district classifications and to zoning the the City: RS-1 Single Family Residential District and M-2 General Manufacturing District. (b) The Plan Commission is directed to prepare an amendment to the zoning ordinance setting forth permanent classifications and regulations for the zoning of the annexed area, and to submit its recommendation to the Council.

SECTION 4. Alderman District Designation. The territory described in Section 1 of this ordinance is hereby made a part of the 6th Ward, 3rd Aldermanic District of the City of Cedarburg subject to

the ordinances, rules and regulations of the City governing aldermanic districts.

SECTION 5. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.


