CHARTER ORDINANCE NUMBER 3

AN ORDINANCE to suspend the operation of Sub-section (7) of Section 62.13 of Wisconsin Statutes relating to compensation of Chiefs and subordinates in the Police and Fire Departments in so far as the same applies to the City of La Crosse.

The Common Council of the City of La Crosse do ordain as follows:

Section 1. By authority of Section 3 of Article XI of the Wisconsin Constitution and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 66.01 of Wisconsin Statutes, it is hereby provided and enacted that Section 62.13 of Wisconsin Statutes, Subsection Seven (7) which provides the method of determining compensation and salaries of Chiefs and subordinates in the Police and Fire Departments is abrogated and amended in so far as the same applies to the method of determining compensation of Chiefs and subordinates of the Police and Fire Departments of the City of La Crosse, and a new section of the Charter of the City of La Crosse to be known as sub-section (7) of Section 62.13 is hereby enacted to read as follows, to-wit:

"(7). COMPENSATION. The salaries of Chiefs and Subordinates shall be fixed by the Council. All other moneys of any nature received by them shall be accounted for in the manner provided in paragraph A of Sub-section (9) and Paragraph A of Sub-section (10) respectively of Section 62.13 of Wisconsin Statutes, and the Chiefs shall make verified reports thereof to the Council quarterly. The Council may provide that the salaries shall increase with length of service, and nothing herein shall interfere with the power of the Council to grant a pension to persons provided in Sub-sections (9) and (10) of Section 62.13 of Wisconsin Statutes."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force sixty days after its passage and publication, unless within said period a referendum petition shall be filed as provided by law, in which event this Ordinance shall not take effect until submitted to a referendum vote and approved by the majority of electors voting thereon.
