At the ~~regular~~ September, 1912, term of Circuit Court, held at the Court House, in the Village of Friendship, in said county; where- in an application was presented to the Court, for an Order appointing three Inspectors to call a meeting of the electors of the territory therein described in said application, to vote upon the question of incorporating said territory as a village by the name of the village of Adams, located in the Town of Adams, in said County and State, and that on the 23rd day of September, 1912, at said term, said Court there- by made an order appointing the undersigned as inspectors for the pur- pose of calling a meeting of the electors of said territory, to vote upon the question of incorporating said territory as a Village by the name of the village of Adams; and

Do hereby certify that we caused notice of the time and place of the meeting of the electors of said territory to vote on the question of incorporating said territory as a village by the name of the village of Adams, to be posted up in three of the most public places within said territory on the 24th day of September, 1912, stating that a meet- ing would be called on the 19th day of October, 1912, at ten o'clock in the forenoon of said day and that the polls would be kept open until four o'clock in the afternoon of said day, as there is no paper printed or published within said territory, and due proof by affidavit, having been made and filed prior to the opening of said meeting, that said notices of said meeting were posted in three of the most public places within said territory on the 24th day of September, 1912, and proof by affidavit, having been duly made and filed prior to the 19th day of October, 1912, that no paper is now or was printed or published within said territory for more than twenty years last past; and on the 19th day of October, 1912, after taking the oath of office, as required by law, we caused the polls to be opened at ten o'clock in the forenoon of said day and kept opened until four o'clock in the afternoon of said day, at the place noticed to call said meeting; and

That after the closing of the polls, we caused a true and correct

canvass of all the ballots cast at said meeting, and the whole number of ballots given thereat, were 126, and the number of ballots given thereat, having thereon the word " yes ", was 124, and the number of ballots given thereat, having thereon the word " no " was 2.
