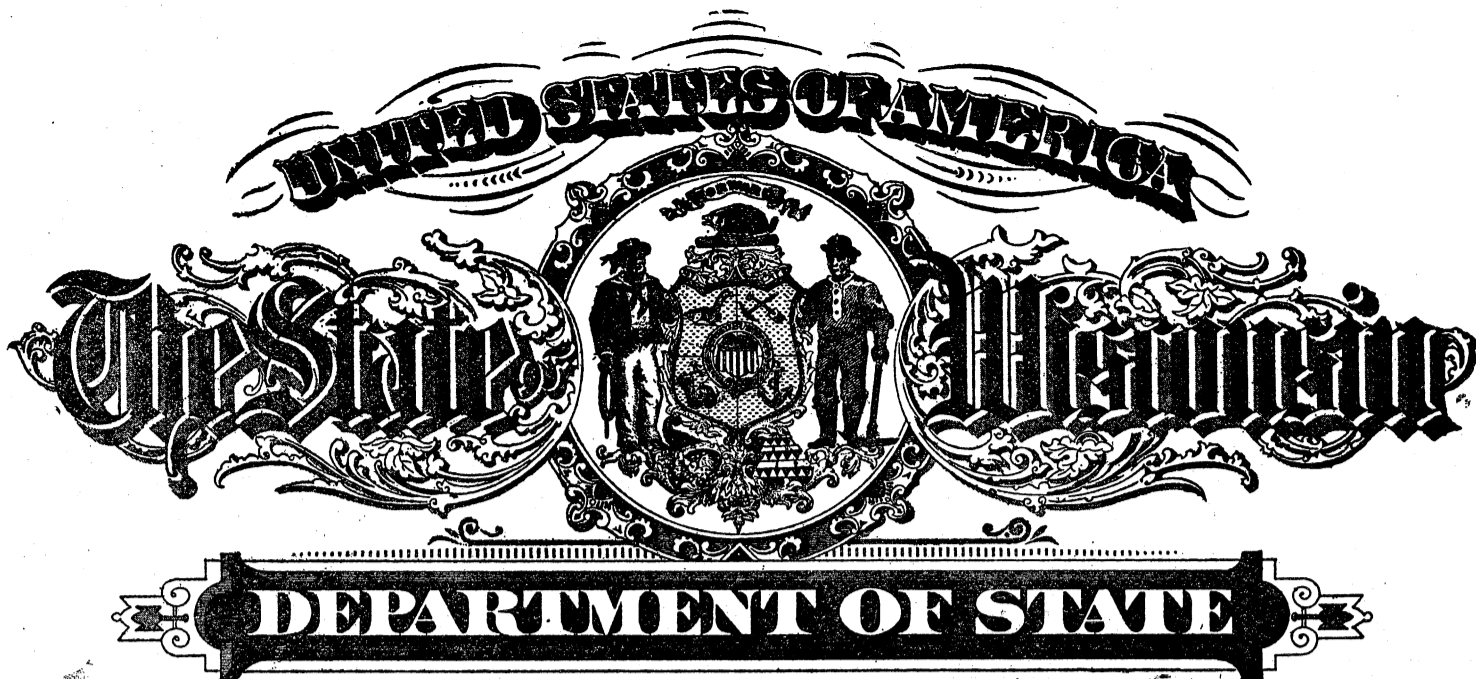

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

OF THE

CITY OF HILLSBORO, VERNON COUNTY, WISCONSIN

(Under Section 61.58 of the Wisconsin Statutes)

I, FRED R. ZIMMERMAN, Secretary of State of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby certify that:

WHEREAS, the Village of Hillsboro, Vernon County, Wisconsin, was incorporated by order of Circuit Court dated October 5, 1885, the incorporation papers thereof being filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of said Vernon County, October 22, 1885, and filed in the office of the Secretary of State October 29, 1917; and

WHEREAS, the clerk of said Village of Hillsboro did, on the eleventh day of October, 1939, file in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Wisconsin, a certificate setting forth the proceedings had, in and by said village, for the purpose of securing a city charter under the provisions of Section 61.58 of the Wisconsin Statutes; and

WHEREAS, from such certificate, it appears:

That the village board of said Village of Hillsboro did cause to be taken on the twenty-fifth day of July, 1939, a census of the population of said village, which census, being correctly tabulated and duly certified, did show a population in excess of one thousand, the total being Eleven Hundred and Twenty-five (1125). And that a verified copy of said census was duly filed as by law required in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Vernon County, Wisconsin;

That in accordance with Subsection (1) of Section 61.58 of the Wisconsin Statutes the trustees of the Village Board of the Village of Hillsboro did, at a regular meeting held on the fourth day of August, 1939, adopt a resolution by a two-thirds vote determining that the Village of Hillsboro become a city of the fourth class;

That on the next succeeding twenty-sixth day of September, 1939, an election was duly called and held pursuant to notice duly given for the purpose of electing officers for the said City of Hillsboro, to-wit: A mayor, a justice of the peace and two aldermen and one supervisor for each of the three wards; also, that such officers were duly and lawfully elected.

That the mayor of the city was authorized by the village board to appoint a city clerk, a city treasurer and a city assessor, subject to the confirmation of the council, to serve until their successors are elected at the next succeeding April election.

That the boundaries of the proposed City of Hillsboro are located in Sections Twenty-five, Twenty-six, Thirty-five and Thirty-six of Township Fourteen (14) North, Range One (1) East, in the County of Vernon and State of Wisconsin, which boundaries are herein more particularly described, to-wit:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northeast quarter of section thirty-four, Township fourteen, North of Range one East of the fourth principal meridian, thence east on the quarter line between the North half and the South half of Section thirty-five and the Northwest quarter and the Southwest quarter of section thirty-six to the southeast corner of the northwest quarter of said section thirty-six. Thence north on the line between the northwest quarter and the northeast quarter of section thirty-six and between the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter and the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section number twenty-five to the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of section twenty-five, thence west on the line between the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter and the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of section number twenty-five and between the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter and the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section number twenty-five and between the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter and the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section number twenty-six and between the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter and the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section number twenty-six and between the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter and the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section number twenty-six and between the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter and the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section number twenty-six to the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of said section number twenty-six, thence south on the line between sections twenty-six and twenty-seven and between sections thirty-five and thirty-four to the place of beginning, containing eighteen (18) forties of land according to government survey, situated in the Town of Hillsboro in Vernon County, Wisconsin, being Township fourteen (14) North, Range one (1) East of the fourth principal meridian.

Said boundaries are more briefly described as including the following:

The North half ( $N\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Section Thirty-five (35); the Northwest quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty-six (36); the South half ( $S\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter ( $SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-five (25); the South half ( $S\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southeast quarter ( $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the South half ( $S\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southwest quarter ( $SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-six (26); all in Township Fourteen (14) North, Range One (1) East of principal meridian, County of Vernon and State of Wisconsin.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FRED R. ZIMMERMAN, Secretary of State of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of authority in me vested, do hereby determine and declare that the Village of Hillsboro in the County of Vernon, and State of Wisconsin, bounded as aforesaid, has been duly incorporated as a city of the Fourth Class, according to the classification of cities as set forth in the Wisconsin Statutes, and that from henceforth the said city shall be known as

THE CITY OF HILLSBORO

and be governed by the provisions of Chapter 62 of the Wisconsin Statutes and laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, applicable to cities of the fourth class.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison, this Eleventh day of October, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine.
