



CERTIFIED MAIL

The Common Council of the City of Galesville, in regular session assembled, do ordain as follows:

It being made to appear that a Petition for Annexation of lands has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Galesville, signed by the owners of all of the land in the area sought to be annexed and hereafter described and there being no residents of said area, and a Notice of Intent to circulate such annexation Petition having heretofore been published as required by law and more than twenty (20) days have elapsed since the publication of Notice of Intent to Circulate and not more than sixty days have elapsed after the date of the filing of the said Petition for Annexation and it further appearing that it is in the best interests of the City of Galesville, and its citizens that said lands be annexed to the said City of Galesville, and it further appearing that the use of such territory in said City of Galesville will be for commercial purposes and is not contrary to any Town or County Zoning Regulation and it further appearing that said lands lie within the Town of Gale, Trempealeau County, Wisconsin and within the boundaries of Joint School District No. 1 of the City of Galesville, et-al, commonly known as Gale-Ettrick-Trempealeau School District and it further appearing that the Notice of Intent to circulate a Petition for Annexation has been served upon the Municipal Clerks and the School Clerks affected by such Petition all as provided by law, as appears from the proof of such mailing on file herein, and that the exact

description of the territory affected by this Ordinance and to be annexed hereby is hereafter set forth and a sketch or map of said territory is annexed hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

IT IS ORDAINED, that the following described lands situated in Trempealeau County, Wisconsin, be and the same are hereby annexed to the City of Calsville, to-wit:

That part of the SW 1/4-NE 1/4 of Sec. 28, T19N, R9W, consisting of 6.73 acres, and described more fully as follows: Commencing at the Southeast corner of said SW 1/4-NE 1/4 28-19-8, THENCE N. 89° 20' W. 552.0 feet along the centerline of the town road to a nail in the pavement, the point of beginning of this description; thence continuing N. 89° 20' W. 797.3 feet along said town road centerline to a nail in the pavement; thence N. 24° 45' E. 35.0 feet to a highway right-of-way post; thence N. 10° 00' E. 254.6 feet along the east right-of-way line of USH 53 to a highway right-of-way post; thence N. 04° 31' W. 104.7 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 89° 31' E. 718.0 feet along the fence to a steel post; thence S 44° 31' E. 31.4 feet to a steel post; thence S 01° 02' E. 367.8 feet to the point of beginning.

All bearings are referenced to the true bearing of N 05° 48' E. of the centerline of pavement of USH 53 as determined by the Wisconsin Division of Highways.

That said lands are located now within and are hereby detached from the Town of Cal, Trempealeau County, Wisconsin.

This Ordinance shall take full force and effect upon passage and publication.

The above Ordinance duly adopted on the 12th day of April, 1979, by a vote of 6 ayes and 0 nays.
