SUBJECT: Change in Boundary Lines  
Village of Omro  
Winnebago County

Dear Sir:

In compliance with your request of yesterday, we are returning attached hereto, the certified copy of the Order of Detachment pertaining to the above subject which was mailed to us recently by Mr. Altman.

It was our intention to send the copy of the Order to our home office together with the revised plats of the Village and Town of Omro in support of the changes made in the common boundary of the two units in January, 1940, with a view to adjusting the mileage of the involved roads for a proper distribution of the local roads and streets allotments. However, if the village will immediately file with the Secretary of State a certificate of the change as provided for in sections 61.18(6), 61.185 and 62.07 of the statutes, the adjustment in road mileages can be made in time to distribute the allotments for the current year in accordance with the change in boundaries. On the other hand, we are not permitted to recognize any boundary changes unless and until the foregoing provisions have been complied with.

In this connection we wish to bring to your attention apparent discrepancies in the detailed description of the detached territory as described in the copy of the Order of Detachment. It appears to us that this does not clearly or correctly describe the territory. The general description (last paragraph of the order) seems to be in order except that the location and dimensions of Outlots 92 and 93 are not defined. Checking with the Register of Deeds for Winnebago County, we found that these outlots lie in the N. W. corner of the East One-half of the S. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$ , and the two lots combined occupy an area 297 feet square. We are attaching a sketch showing the detached territory and which shows the location of Outlots 92 and 93.

We suggest that the description in the Order of Detachment be supplemented with corrected written descriptions or a sketch, or both, when filing the certificate with the Secretary of State.

ORDER OF DETACHMENT.

. . . .

At a regular term of the Circuit Court of Winnebago County, Wisconsin, begun and held at the Courthouse, in the City of Oshkosh, Winnebago County, Wisconsin, on the 8th day of January, A. D., 1940, and on said 8th day of January, 1940.

Present: Hon. Henry P. Hughes, Circuit Judge, Presiding.

. . . .

This matter having come on for hearing on the 23rd day of December, A.D., 1939, pursuant to notice, and having been duly adjourned to January 8, 1940, at two o'clock in the afternoon of said day, the petitioners being represented by Walter J. Patri, of the firm of Barber, Keefe, Patri, Stillman & Nolan, and the Village of Omro being represented by Attorney Rodney Alder, and there being no other appearances;

And it appearing that H. Spiegelberg, W. R. Ward, Hattie B. Ward, Charles Allen, Hannah M. King, A. D. Cady, and Mrs. August Immisch, pursuant to the provisions of Section 61.18 of the Wisconsin Statutes for 1937, made application to the Circuit Court of Winnebago County, Wisconsin, for detachment of property owned by them, as hereinafter described, from the Village of Omro to the adjacent township of the Town of Omro, Winnebago County, Wisconsin, which said application was left with the village clerk for a period of three weeks or more from the first publication of the notice of such application, proof of which fact was given by the clerk in her testimony; and it also appearing that a map and census was duly made and prepared in compliance with the Statutes in such case made and provided, which were also left with the village clerk for examination; and it also appearing that notice of such hearing was duly published once a week for six weeks in

the Omro Herald, as required by law, proof of such publication having been filed herein;

✓ And it further appearing that the Village Board of the Village of Omro, Wisconsin, under date of November 2, 1939, duly passed a resolution consenting to such proposed alteration;

And it further appearing that the allegations of the application are true;

And the Court having taken testimony in the matter and being fully advised in the matter, and upon all the records and files herein, and upon motion of Barber, Keefe, Patri, Stillman & Nolan, attorneys for the applicants;

IT IS ORDERED, that the following described property of the following named persons be and the same is hereby detached from the Village of Omro, Wisconsin, to the Town of Omro, Wisconsin, to-wit:

 $NE\frac{1}{4}$  of  $SE\frac{1}{4}$  and  $NE\frac{1}{4}$  of  $NW\frac{1}{4}$  of  $SE\frac{1}{4}$ , all in Sec. 17, T. 18, North of Range 15 East, Charles Allen;  
South Half of  $NW\frac{1}{4}$  of  $SE\frac{1}{4}$  and North Quarter of  $SW\frac{1}{4}$  of the  $SE\frac{1}{4}$ , all in Sec. 17, T. 18 North of Range 15, East, Hannah M. King and A. D. Cady;

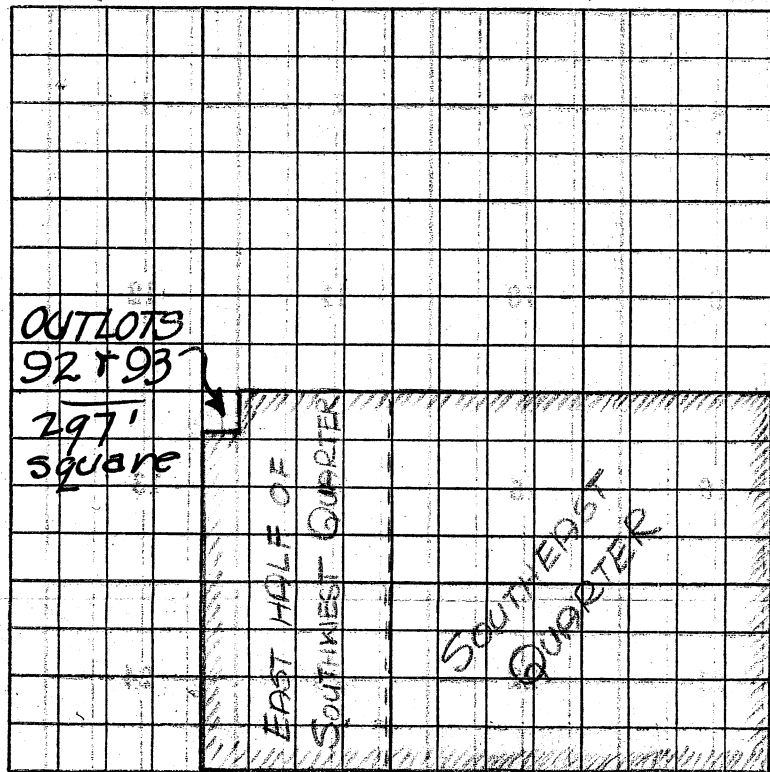
