

COCEEDINGS OF MIDDLETON COMMON COUNCIL (CONTINUED) September 5, 1967: and by more than one-half of the electors residing therein, and said territory being continguous to the City of Middleton;

WHEREAS, a notice of intention to circulate a petition for annexation was duly published in the Middleton Times-Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in the territory, on July 1967, and copies thereof were duly served by registered mail upon the State Director of the Planning Function of the Department of Resource Development, the Clerk of the Town of Middleton, and the Clerk of the City of Middleton within five days of the date of publication of said notice, and

Beginning at the Northeast corner of the Southeast 4 of Section 2, Town 7 North, Range 8 East, Town of Middleton, thence South 88° 56' West 172.67 feet; thence South 1° 15' East 190 feet; thence South 88° 56' West 8.83 feet; thence South 1° 15' East, to the Northeasterly right-of-way line of Century Avenue (C.T.H. "M"); thence Southeasterly along the Northeasterly right-of-way line of Century Avenue to the Centerline of High Road; thence North 10 15' West, to the point of beginning.
