CHARTER ORDINANCE 1988-1

A CHARTER ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE REPLACEMENT
OF THE CITY ENGINEER BY A CITIZEN MEMBER
ON THE CITY OF MIDDLETON PLAN COMMISSION

The Common Council of the City of Middleton do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: The City of Middleton pursuant to section 62.63(1)(a) and section 66.01 of the Wisconsin Statutes hereby elects not to be governed by those portions of section 62.23(1)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes, requiring that the City Engineer be a voting member of the "City Plan Commission" for the City of Middleton which are in conflict with this ordinance.

SECTION 2: Effective sixty (60) days after the publication of this charter ordinance, the City Engineer will be replaced as a voting member of the City Plan Commission.

SECTION 3: Effective sixty (60) days after the publication of this charter ordinance, the City Engineer will be appointed as an alternate member of the Plan Commission and the alternate shall act with full power when any other member of the Plan Commission is absent or refuses to act because of a conflict of interest.


SECTION 4: Any charter provision or any previously enacted ordinance or charter ordinance inconsistent or in conflict herewith is hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 5: This charter ordinance shall take effect sixty (60) days after its passage and publication subject to the provisions of section 66.01 of the Wisconsin Statutes.


The above and foregoing ordinance was duly adopted by the Middleton Common Council at a special meeting held on the 19 day of April, 1988.
