



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CERTIFICATE OF ANNEXATION

I, MARTIN FIESS, Village Clerk of the Village of Verona, County of Dane, State of Wisconsin, DO HEREBY CERTIFY that the following described territory was detached from the Town of Verona, County of Dane, and was annexed to the said Village of Verona, pursuant to Section 66.021 of the Wisconsin Statutes, by an Ordinance adopted by the Village Board at a regular meeting held September 14, 1964:

Part of the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 22, Town 6 North, Range 8 East, Town of Verona, Dane County, Wisconsin, bounded on the North by a line 805.5 feet South of the North line of said 1/4 1/4, also being the present Village limits; bounded on the South and East by the centerline of Badger Mill Creek; bounded on the West by the West line of said 1/4 1/4; also together with part of the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of said Section 22 lying North of the centerline of Badger Mill Creek.

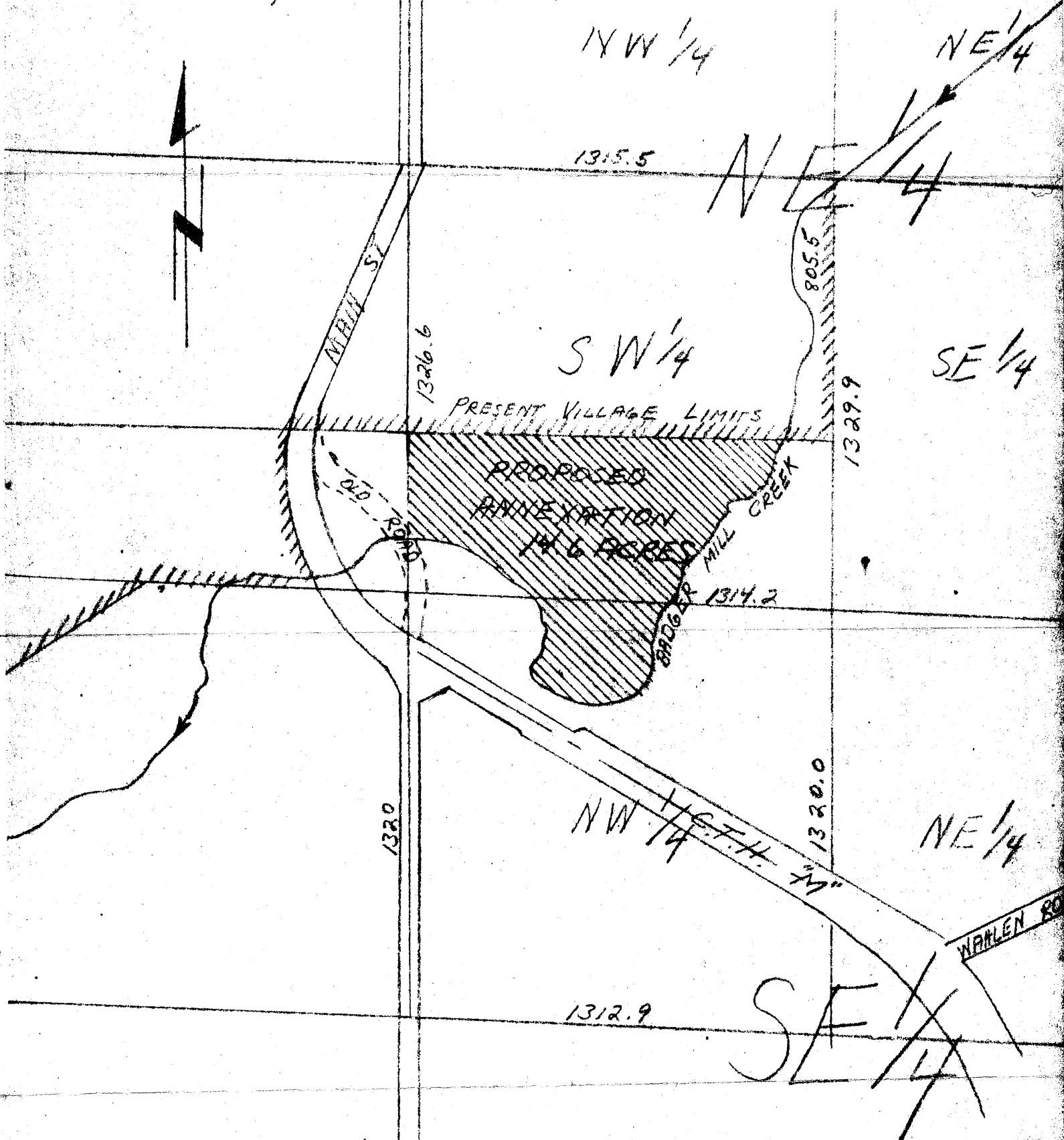
