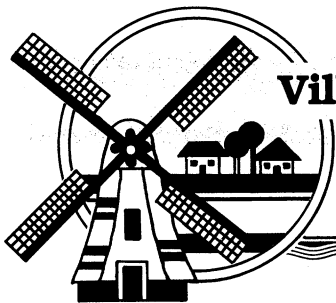

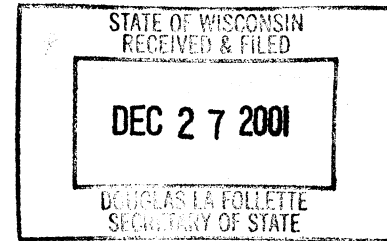

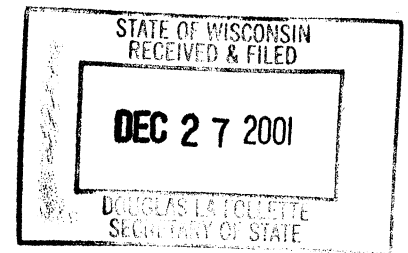

ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. 24, SERIES OF 2001



AN ANNEXATION ORDINANCE ADOPTED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LITTLE CHUTE PURSUANT TO SECTION 66.021 OF THE WISCONSIN STATUTES, ANNEXING TERRITORY FROM THE TOWN OF VANDENBROEK.

WHEREAS, a Petition for Annexation (from Henry Joosten) has been presented to the Village of Little Chute under statutory authority 66.021(12), Wisconsin Statutes as amended; and,

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all the electors and property owners of the proposed area for annexation; and,

WHEREAS, said Petition for Annexation and Notice contain a legal description of the territory proposed to be annexed sufficiently accurate to determine its location, designates the area to be annexed to the Village of Little Chute, designates the area as being proposed to be detached from the Town of Vandebroek as located in Outagamie County; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed petition for annexation was submitted to the State of Wisconsin Department of Administration for review; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Little Chute Board of Trustees has determined that the proposed annexation is in the best interests of the Village of Little Chute and the electors and owners of real estate in the proposed annexation area; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Little Chute Plan Commission has recommended in favor of the proposed annexation; and,

WHEREAS, an Annexation Ordinance of the proposed territory by the Village of Little Chute requires a two-thirds vote of the governing body (Board of Trustees) of the Village of Little Chute;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Little Chute as located in Outagamie County, State of Wisconsin, as follows:

1. That the real estate described hereinafter as:


Beginning at the Northeast Corner of Section 16 T21N R18E; South along East line said Section 16 1217.73 feet to Center of Highway '41', West 355.52 feet, Continuing Westerly 964.00 feet, North 1255.56 feet to North line of Evergreen Drive, East along North line of Evergreen Drive 553.51 feet, South to North line of said Section 16.33.01 feet, East 765.77 feet to Northeast corner of Section 16 and the Point of Beginning, Containing 37.48 Acres.


which is the same real estate as set forth in the Annexation Petition, be hereby annexed to the Village of Little Chute as located in Outagamie County, State of Wisconsin.

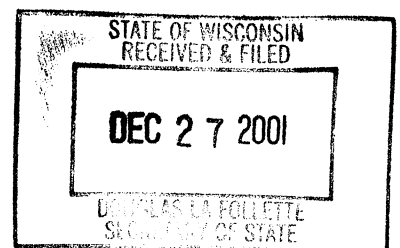
2. The territory is annexed to the Village for zoning purposes as CH-Commercial Highway.
3. That Exhibit "A", a scale map of the area, showing the boundaries of annexation territory and its relationship to the boundaries of the Village of Little Chute, is hereby adopted by reference.
4. The current population of the territory being annexed is zero (0) people, determined in accordance with the definition under Section 66.013(2)(b), Wisconsin Statutes.
5. This Annexation Ordinance shall be effective upon its enactment by a two-thirds vote of the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Little Chute and conditioned upon a finding by the State of Wisconsin Department of Administration that the annexation is not against the public interest.
6. The Village Clerk of the Village of Little Chute shall file immediately with the Wisconsin Secretary of State a certified copy of this Annexation Ordinance with each company providing utility services in the area annexed. One certified copy of this Annexation Ordinance shall be provided to the Outagamie County Register of Deeds for recording/filing purposes, and one certified copy shall be filed with the Clerk of each affected school district.

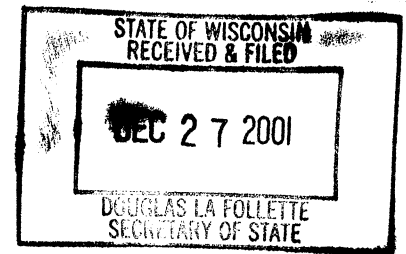

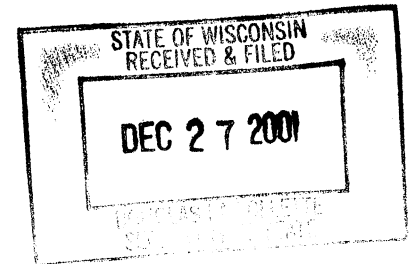

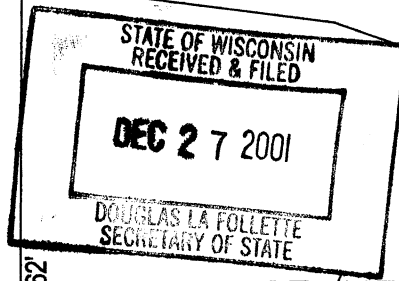
HENRY JOOSTEN ANNEXATION MAP
