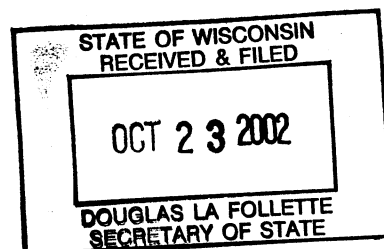



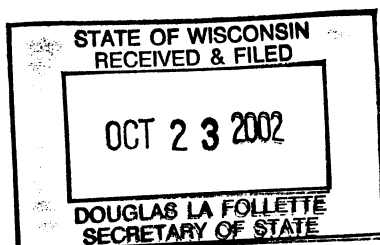

**ORDINANCE NO. 1-2002**

**AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE  
CITY OF DARLINGTON, WISCONSIN**

The Common Council of the City of Darlington, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Territory Annexed. In accordance with Section 66.0217 of the Wisconsin Statutes and the Petition for Direct Annexation by Unanimous Approval filed with the City Clerk-Treasurer on the 8th day of October, 2002 and with the Town Clerk of the Town of Darlington, signed by all of the electors residing in the territory and all of the owners of real property in the territory, the following described territory in the Town of Darlington, Lafayette County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the City of Darlington Lafayette County, Wisconsin.

Part of the NE¼ of the NE¼ of Section 9, Town 2 North, Range 3 East, Darlington Township, Lafayette County, Wisconsin, being more fully described as:

Commencing at the NE corner of Section 9;

thence South 0°03'40" W on the East line of the NE¼, 77.00' to a point on the South right-of-way of State Trunk Highway "81" and the point of beginning;

thence continuing S 0°03'40" W, 500.00';

thence N 89°50'50" W, 657.03';

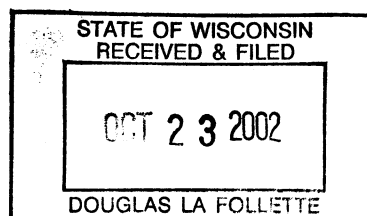
thence N 0°12'21" E, 500.00' to a point on said South right-of-way;

thence S 89°50'50" E, 655.77' to the point of beginning.

Parcel contains 7.53 acres (328,198 sq. ft.), more or less, and is subject to any and all easements and rights-of-way of record and/or usage.

SECTION 2. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this Ordinance the territory described in Section 1 shall be part of the City of Darlington for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the City of Darlington.

SECTION 3. Temporary Zoning Classification. (a) Pursuant to the City of Darlington Zoning Ordinance, the territory annexed to the City of Darlington by this Ordinance is temporarily designated to be part of the BP Business Park District of the City for zoning purposes and subject



to all provisions of said zoning ordinance relating to such district classification and to zoning in the City.

(b) The Plan Commission is directed to prepare an amendment to the zoning ordinance setting forth permanent classifications and regulations for the zoning of the annexed area and to submit its recommendations to the Common Council not later than 60 days from this date.

SECTION 4. Ward Designation. The territory described in Section 1 of this Ordinance is hereby made a part of election ward one of the City of Darlington, subject to the ordinances, rules and regulators of the City governing wards.

SECTION 5. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

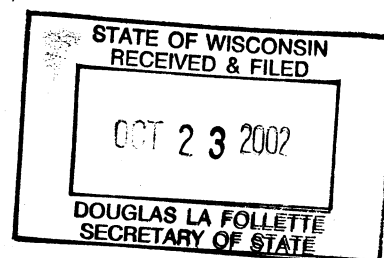

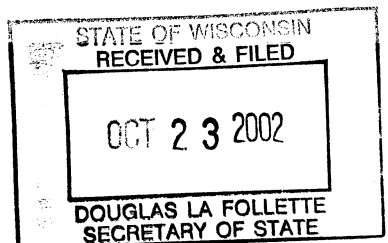
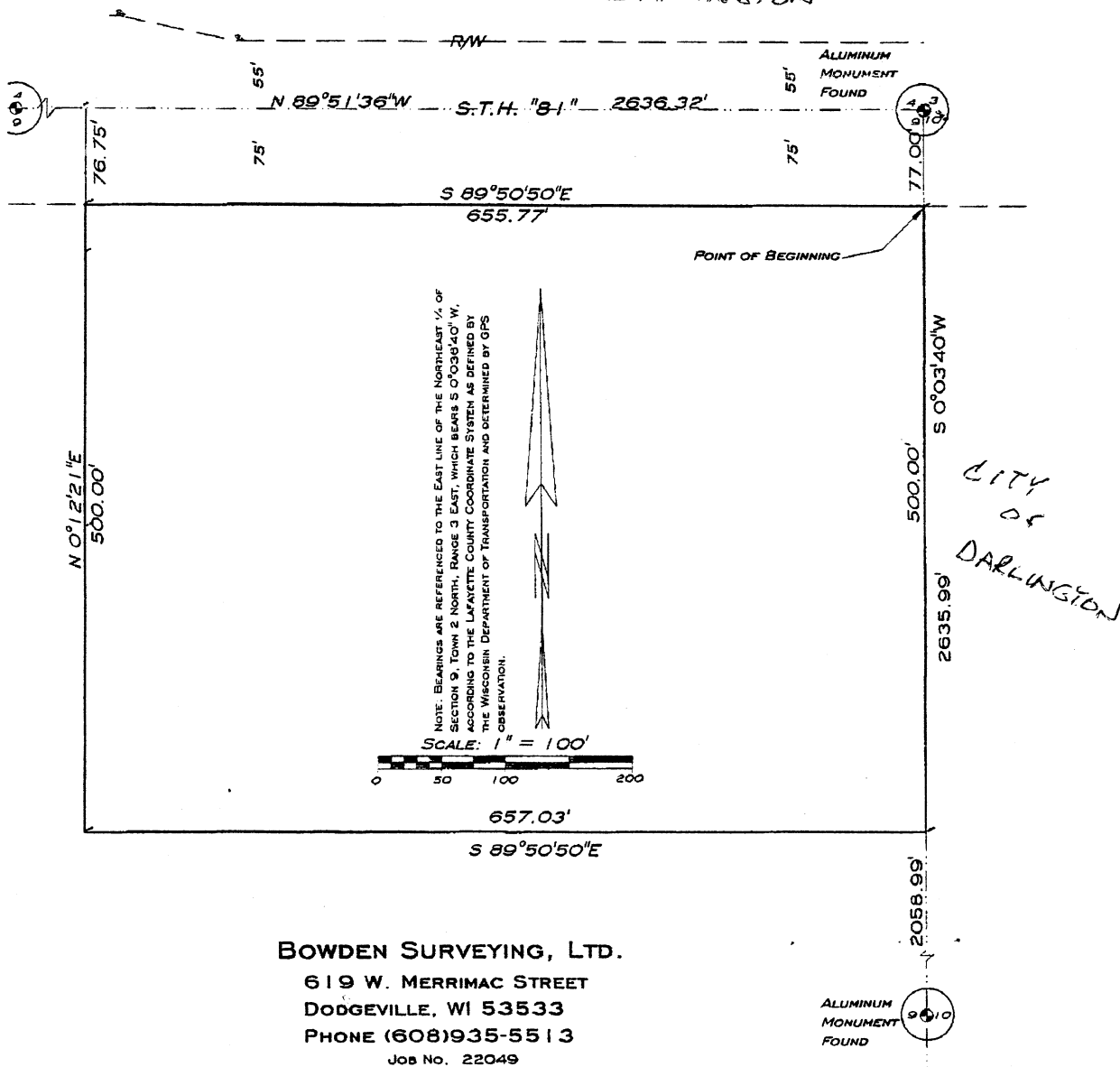


## PLOT OF SURVEY FOR THE CITY OF DARLINGTON



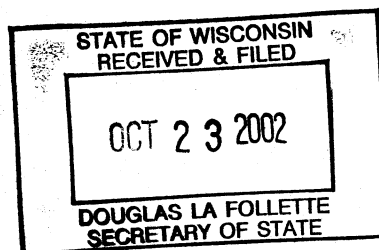


