## RESOLUTION



WHEREAS, The Village of Amherst, Portage County, Wisconsin has been presented a petition by John F. Wolter, d/b/a G & J Farms, owners of an interest in the real estate presently located in the Town of Amherst, Portage County, Wisconsin for annexation to the Village of Amherst, Portage County, Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned real estate is contiguous to the Village of Amherst, but is located in the Township of Amherst, Portage County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:

Part of the Portage County Certified Survey Map #2477 located in the SW1/4 of the SW1/4, NW1/4 of the SW1/4, and the SE1/4 of the SW1/4 of Section 27, Township 23 North, Range 10 East, Town of Amherst, Portage County, Wisconsin.

Being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the SW corner of Section 27, Thence N 00° 29'04" W along the West line of SW1/4 1148.12', Thence N 89° 29'58" E to the East right of way County Trunk Highway "A" 33.00' to a found 3/4" rebar and the Point of Beginning;

Thence N 78<sup>0</sup>45'56" E along said CSM 231.60' to a point on the South Right of Way of State Highway Trunk "10" marked by a set 1" iron pipe;

Thence S 57<sup>0</sup>13'00" E along said right of way 84.08 to the start of a curve marked by a 3/4" rebar;

Thence continuing along the arc of a curve to the left, said curve having radius of 4206.850', a chord length of

540.83' which bears S 49°39'08" E an arc length of 541.20' to a point at the intersection of said right of way and the East line of CSM #2477 marked by a set 1" iron pipe;

Thence S 02047'11" W along said CSM 334.17' to a found

3/4" rebar.

Thence S 50°17'08" W 43.87' to a found 3/4" rebar; Thence S 02°47'13" W 215.38' to a point on the South line of SW1/4 of said section marked by a found 3/4" rebar;

Thence S 89<sup>0</sup>07'24" W along said South line 116.54' to a meander corner marked by a set 1" iron pipe;

Thence N 72<sup>0</sup>58'48" W along said meander line 997.72' to a point marked by a 1" iron pipe;

Thence S 86<sup>0</sup>03'06" W along said meander line 302.30' to a point marked by a 1" iron pipe;

Thence S 54<sup>0</sup>22'58" W along said meander line 171.94' to a point marked by a 1" iron pipe;

Thence N 80<sup>O</sup>32'56" W along said meander line 77.87' to a point marked by a 1" iron pipe;

Thence N 02<sup>0</sup>38'05" W along said meander line 114.24' to a point marked by a set 1" iron pipe;

Thence N 62<sup>0</sup>59'55" W along said meander line 230.80' to a point marked by a 1" iron pipe;

Thence S 70°32'10" W along said meander line 266.55' to a point on the East line of County Trunk Highway "A"; Thence N 00°29'04" W along said right of way 930.18' to the point of beginning and there terminating subject to restrictions, reservations, right of way and easements of record.

Intending to include lands lying South of the described meander line to the South waters edge of the Waupaca/Tomorrow River.

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission of the Village of Amherst has presented a favorable recommendation to the request for annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Amherst deems it in the best interests of the Village of Amherst to annex the aforementioned real estate to the Village of Amherst, and to designate the parcel to be zoned as <a href="#">Agricultural</a>;


NOW THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Amherst, Wisconsin, consistent with the provisions of Section 66 of the Wisconsin Statutes, do ordain as follows:

1. The Code of Ordinances of the Village of Amherst is hereby amended to make a part of the Village of Amherst that real estate more particularly described as follows:

Part of the Portage County Certified Survey Map #2477 located in the SW1/4 of the SW1/4, NW1/4 of the SW1/4, and the SE1/4 of the SW1/4 of Section 27, Township 23



North, Range 10 East, Town of Amherst, Portage County, Wisconsin. Being more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the SW corner of Section 27, Thence N 000 29'04" W along the West line of SW1/4 1148.12', Thence N 89029'58" E to the East right of way County Trunk Highway "A" 33.00' to a found 3/4" rebar and the Point of Beginning; Thence N 89029'58" E along said right of way 25.31' to a found 3/4" rebar; Thence N 00 029'47" W along said right of way 289.80' to a found 3/4" rebar; Thence N 12 035'58" E along said right of way 437.58' to a point on the South right of way of State Highway Trunk "10" marked by 3/4" rebar; Thence S 69036'24" E along said right of way 931.38' to a found 3/4" rebar and the start of a curve; Thence continuing along the arc of a curve to the right, said curve having a radius of 738.19'; a cord length of 302.42' which bears S 57047'11" E, and an arc length of 304.57' to a point on said right of way marked by a 3/4" rebar: Thence S 35°56'09" E along said right of way 188.36' to a found 3/4" rebar; Thence S 51015'23" E along said right of way to a point on the West line of CSM #2316 38.77; Thence S 00°15'49" E along said CSM 228.24' to a set 1" iron pipe; Thence N 78045'56" E along said CSM 231.60' to a point on the South Right of Way of State Highway Trunk "10" marked by a set 1" iron pipe; Thence S 57013'00" E along said right of way 84.08 to the start of a curve marked by a 3/4" rebar; Thence continuing along the arc of a curve to the left, said curve having radius of 4206.850', a chord length of 540.83' which bears S 49 39'08" E an arc length of 541.20' to a point at the intersection of said right of way and the East line of CSM #2477 marked by a set 1" iron pipe; Thence S 02047'11" W along said CSM 334.17' to a found 3/4" rebar. Thence S  $50^{\circ}17'08$ " W 43.87' to a found 3/4" rebar; Thence S 02047'13" W 215.38' to a point on the South line of SW1/4 of said section marked by a found 3/4" rebar; Thence S 89007'24" W along said South line 116.54' to a meander corner marked by a set 1" iron pipe; Thence N 72058'48" W along said meander line 997.72' to a point marked by a 1" iron pipe; Thence S 86003'06" W along said meander line 302.30' to a point marked by a 1" iron pipe; Thence N 54022'58" W along said meander line 171.94' to a point marked by a 1" iron pipe; Thence S 80032'56" W along said meander line 77.87' to



a point marked by a 1" iron pipe;
Thence N 02<sup>0</sup>38'05" W along said meander line 114.24' to a point marked by a set 1" iron pipe;
Thence N 62<sup>0</sup>59'55" W along said meander line 230.80' to a point marked by a 1" iron pipe;
Thence S 70<sup>0</sup>32'10" W along said meander line 266.55' to a point on the East line of County Trunk Highway "A";
Thence N 00<sup>0</sup>29'04" W along said right of way 930.18' to the point of beginning and there terminating subject to restrictions, reservations, right of way and easements of record.
Intending to include lands lying South of the described meander line to the South waters edge of the Waupaca/Tomorrow River.

- 2. LET IT FURTHER BE RESOLVED, that the parcel shall be zoned as agricultural.
