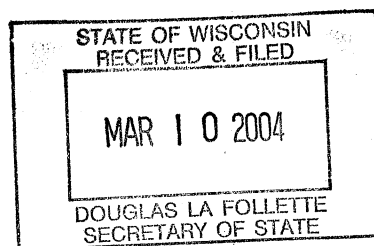

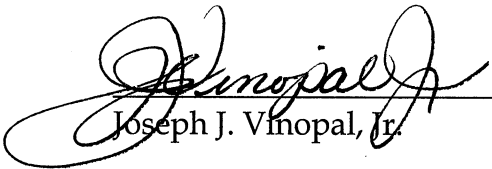

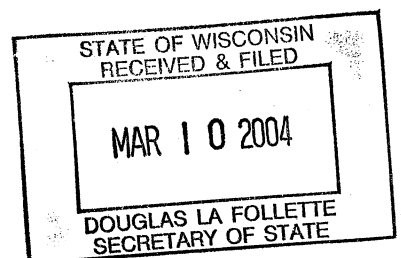

VILLAGE OF ALMENA, WISCONSIN.**

Joseph J. Vinopal, Jr., duly elected Village Clerk of the Village of Almena, Barron County, Wisconsin, being duly sworn does hereby certify that attached hereto is a true and correct copy of Ordinance No. 2004 - # 01 annexing certain lands to the Village of Almena, Wisconsin, said land being part of the Town of Almena, Barron County, Wisconsin.

The undersigned does further certify that attached hereto is a true and correct description of the lands annexed and further certifies that the population of said land is one inhabitant.

ORDINANCE No. 2004 - # 01, AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF ALMENA, WISCONSIN.

The Board of the Village of Almena, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Territory Annexed. In accordance with Sec. 66.021 of the Wisconsin Statutes and the Petition for Direct Annexation filed with the Village Clerk on the 15th day of January, 2004, signed by all electors/owners of the land, described in the Petition for Annexation, the following described territory in the Town of Almena, Barron County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the Village of Almena, Wisconsin.

The NE-NW, 24-34-14, Town of Almena, Barron County, Wisconsin.

SECTION 2: Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this ordinance the territory described in Section 1 shall be part of the Village of Almena for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules, and regulations governing the Village of Almena.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.

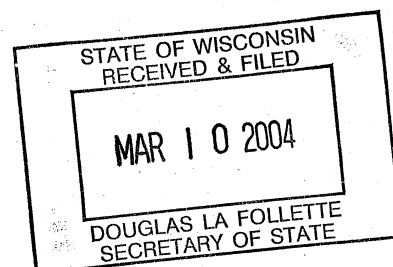

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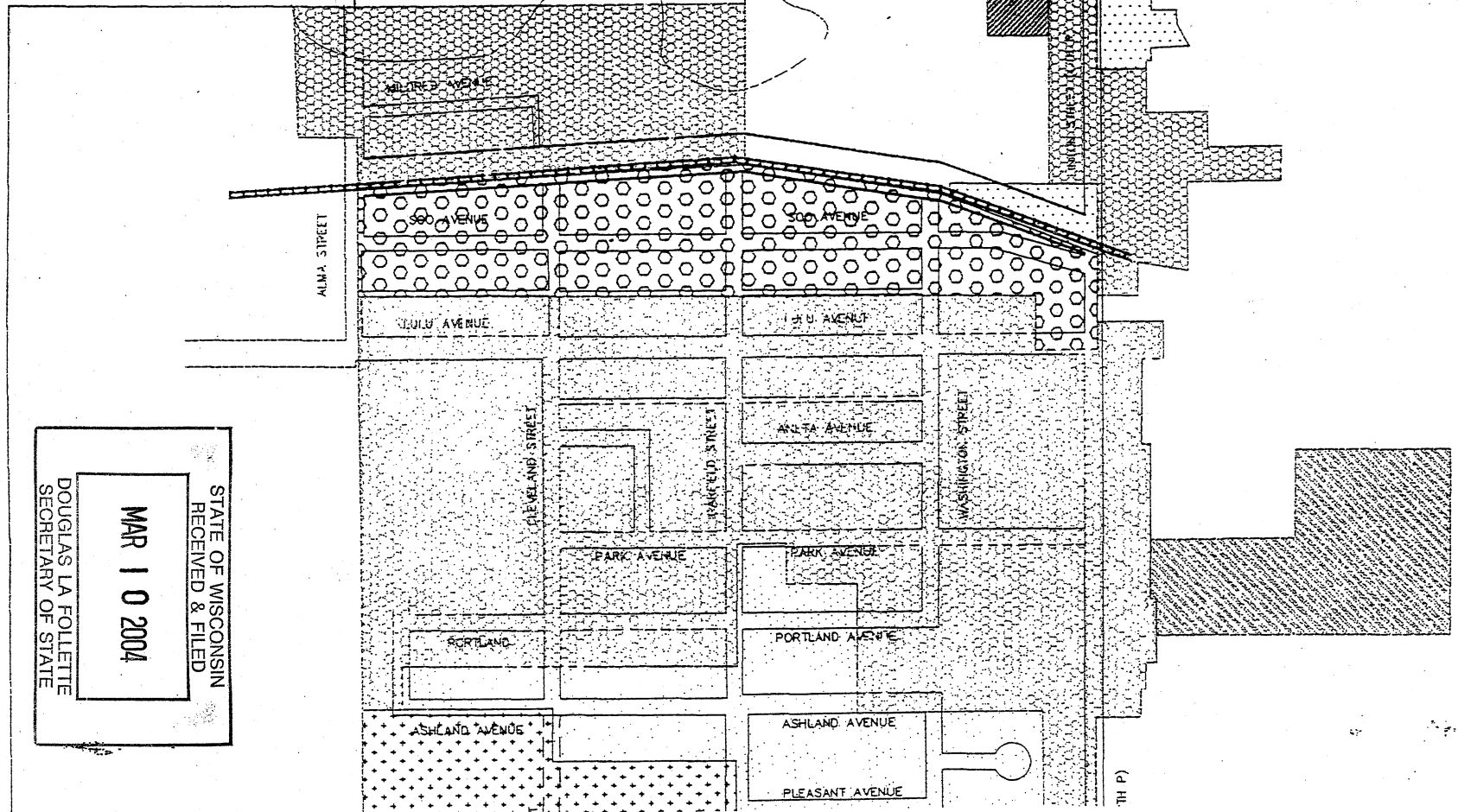

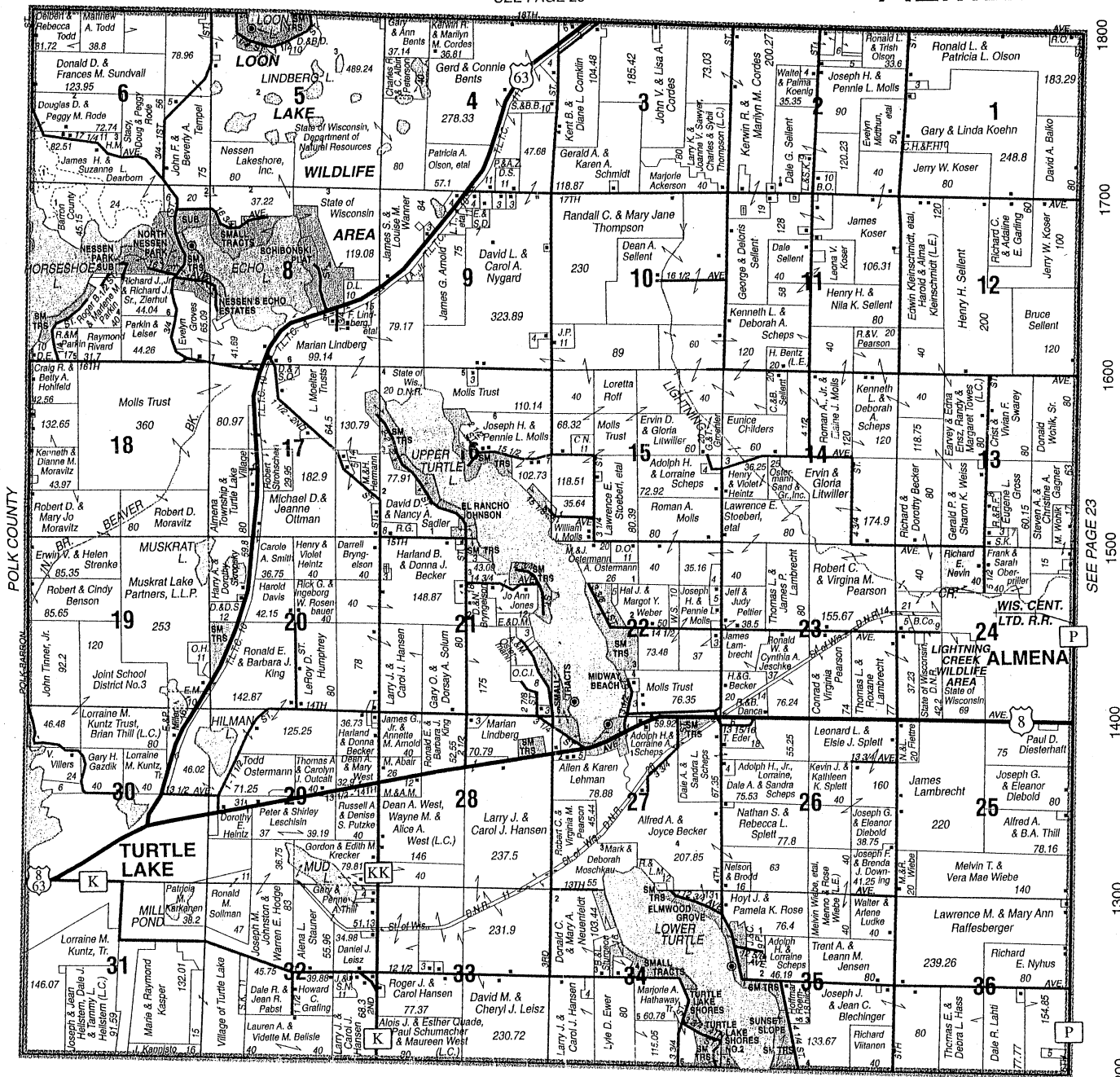
