**ORDINANCE NO. 2007 - #3, AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY
TO THE VILLAGE OF ALMENA, WISCONSIN**

The board of the Village of Almena, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Territory Annexed. In accordance with Sec. 66.021 of the Wisconsin Statutes and the Petition for Direct Annexation filed with the Village Clerk on the 14 day of AUGUST, 2007, signed by all owners of the land, described in the Petition for Annexation, the following described territory in the Town of Almena, Barron County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the Village of Almena, Wisconsin:

The South 635 feet of the West 775 feet of SW-SE, 13-34-14, Barron County, WI.

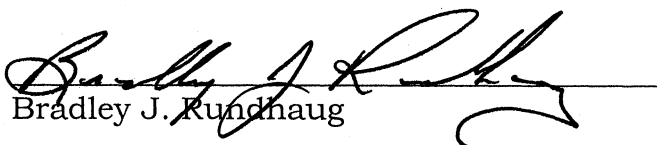
SECTION 2: Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this ordinance the territory described in Section 1 shall be part of the Village of Almena for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the Village of Almena.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

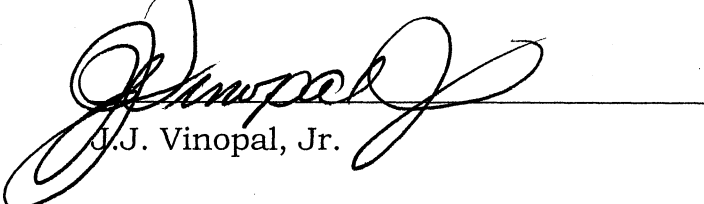
SECTION 4. Population. The population of the territory annexed hereunder is currently seven (7).

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.

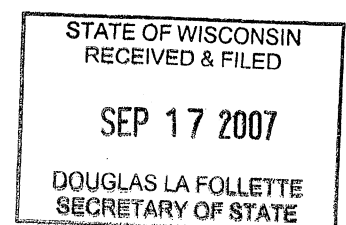

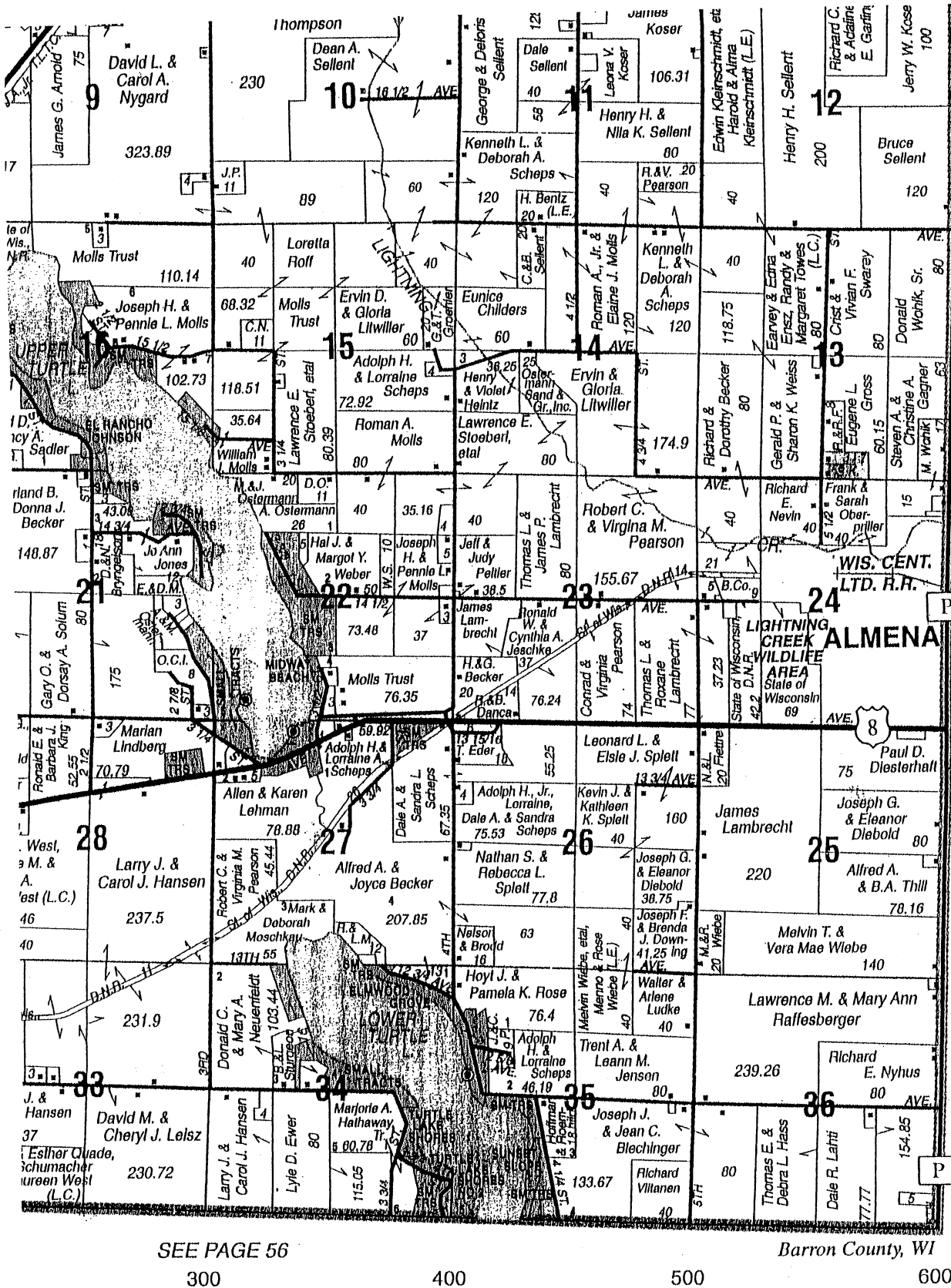
