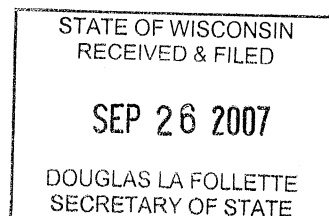

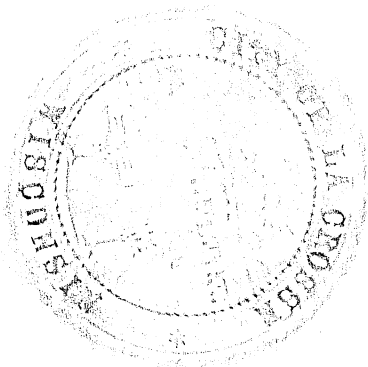

AN AMENDED CHARTER ORDINANCE to amend Subsection 2.18(A) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse to make the student representatives ex officio non-voting members.

THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: Subsection 2.18(A) is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

2.18 MUNICIPAL TRANSIT UTILITY.

(A) MEMBERSHIP.

The Municipal Transit Utility Board shall consist of the following members:

- (1) The Board of Public Works as defined in Section 2.08 of this Code, as amended or superseded;
- (2) Two unpaid citizen residents of the City, preferably persons who regularly utilize or ride the Municipal Transit Utility buses, who shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council for a term of two (2) years beginning on the first day in September 1988;
- (3) An unpaid student representative from each of the City's institutions of higher education, which currently consist of three (3) institutions. Said student representatives shall serve for an initial term commencing upon the effective date of this ordinance through May 31, 2008. Upon expiration of the initial term, the term shall be for one (1) year beginning on June 1, 2008 and each year thereafter. The Mayor shall appoint the student representative subject to confirmation by the Council. The student government of each institution shall submit its recommendation of a single candidate for appointment, if any, to the City no later than the first day of May immediately preceding the commencement of the student representative's term for review by the Council prior to final confirmation.
- (4) Other communities or municipalities that have a contract with the La Crosse Municipal Transit Utility and receive service from the Transit Utility may appoint an unpaid additional non-voting member to the Municipal Transit Utility Board who may be a member of the governing body of such other community or a citizen of such other community. The term of such other community non-voting member shall be for two (2) years unless such other community service contract with the La Crosse Municipal Transit Utility terminates and is not renewed within any two (2) year term.
- (5) Three (3) unpaid alternates to be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council. ~~The initial term shall commence upon the effective date of this ordinance until [DATE], 2008.~~



~~Upon the expiration of the initial term, the term shall be for one (1) year beginning on [DATE], 2008 and each year thereafter. Annually, the Mayor shall designate one of the alternate members as first alternate and the others as second and third alternates respectively. The first alternate shall act, with full power, only when a voting member of the Municipal Transit Utility Board is absent. The second and subsequent alternates shall so act only upon the absence of multiple voting members or the first or preceding alternate. This paragraph shall expire on May 21, 2009.~~

SECTION II: This ordinance shall take effect sixty (60) days after its passage and publication subject to the provisions of Section 66.0101, Wis. Stats.
