The Common Council of the City of Wausau do ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Territory Annexed</u>. In accordance with Chapter 66, Wisconsin Statutes, and the petition for direct annexation signed by Willi Preu, Irmgard Preu, Peter Preu, Robert Feira, and Delores Feria, sole owners of the land now located in the Town of Stettin, Marathon County, Wisconsin, and being a part of the Wausau School District, the following described land is hereby annexed to the City of Wausau:

Part of the SW¹/₄ of the NW¹/₄ and part of the NW¹/₄ of the SW¹/₄, Section 28, Township 29 North, Range 7 East, Town of Stettin, Marathon County, Wisconsin, described as follows:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of said SW¹/₄ of the NW¹/₄; thence East, along the South line of said SW¹/₄ of the NW¹/₄, 300 feet to the West line of Lot 1 of Indian Springs extended Northerly, the point of beginning:

Thence South, along said West line extended Northerly, 30 feet to the Northwest corner of said Lot 1, thence East, along the North line of said Lot 1, 100 feet to the Northeast corner of said Lot 1; thence East, along the South right-of-way of Hilltop Avenue, 160 feet to a line 560 feet East of and parallel with the West line of said NW¹/₄ of the SW¹/₄; thence North, along said parallel line, 30 feet to said South line of the SW¹/₄ of the NW¹/₄; thence East, along said South line, 200 feet to the West line of Lot 2 of Certified Survey Map No. 14517 recorded in the office of Register of Deeds for Marathon County in Volume 64 of Certified Survey Maps on page 154, extended Southerly; thence North, along said West line extended Southerly, 33 feet to the North right-of-way of Hilltop Avenue; thence North, along said West line, 208 feet to the South line of Lot 1 of Certified Survey Map No. 7295 recorded in the office of Register of Deeds for Marathon County in Volume 28 of Certified Survey Maps on page 68; thence West, along said South line, 100 feet to a line 660 feet East of and parallel with the West line of said SW¹/₄ of the NW¹/₄; thence South, along said parallel line, 208 feet to said North right-of-way of Hilltop Avenue; thence West, alongsaid North right-of-way, 100 feet to a line 560 feet East of and parallel with said West line of the SW¼ of the NW¼; thence North, along said parallel line, 208 feet to said South line of Lot 1 of Certified Survey

Map No. 7295; thence West, along said South line, 100 feet to a line 460 feet East of and parallel with said West line of the SW¹/₄ of the NW¹/₄; thence South, along said West line, 208 feet to said North right-of-way of Hilltop Avenue: thence continuing South along said parallel line, 33 feet to said South line of the SW¹/₄ of the NW¹/₄; thence West, along said South line, 160 feet to said West line of Lot 1 of Indian Springs extended Northerly, the point of beginning.

Section 2. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of publication of this ordinance, the territory described in Section 1 shall be a part of the City of Wausau and remain a part of the Wausau School District for any and all purposes provided by law, and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the City of Wausau, and governing the School District.

Section 3. Zoning Classifications. Zoning of the within real estate shall be pursuant to Section 23.04.020, Zoning of Annexed Lands, of the Wausau Municipal Code.

Section 4. Aldermanic District. The territory described in Section 1 of this ordinance is hereby made a part of the 9th Aldermanic District and the 67th Ward of the City of Wausau, subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the city, county, and state, governing districts.

The population of the annexed territory is zero (0).

Section 5. The State of Wisconsin, Department of Administration, has reviewed the annexation and found it to be against the public interest.

Section 6. Agreement to Pay Town Taxes. The City shall pay to the Town of Stettin all necessary property taxes that are due and owing pursuant to the provisions of Section 66.0221(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 7. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance, which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

Section 8. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
