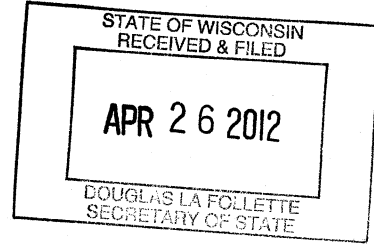

ORDINANCE AMENDING NUMBER  
OF TRUSTEES

The Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Rosholt, Portage County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

1. That the number of trustees of the Board of Trustees, at present numbering seven (7), shall be and hereby is reduced to five (5).
2. Although as of the date of the passage of this Ordinance, the number of Village Trustees is set at seven (7), the number of trustees actually holding office is five (5), given that there are two vacancies as of the time of this Ordinance's passage.
3. State law provides as follows: "Any village may by ordinance change the number of trustees, but such change in the number of trustees shall not affect the term of office of trustees elected prior to the adoption of such ordinance authorizing such change." §61.20(4), Wis. Stats.
4. This Ordinance amends that portion of the Village Charter Ordinance that originally set the number of trustees at seven (7), pursuant to §66.0101(2)(b),
5. The reduction from seven (7) to five (5) trustees shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law.
