CITY OF SHULLSBURG CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 308

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL SECTION 1.01 AND REPEAL AND RECREATE SECTION 1.01 OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES

The Common Council of the City of Shullsburg, Lafayette County, Wisconsin, do hereby ordain as follows:

- 1. Section 1.01shall be repealed and recreated to now read as follows:
 - (a) **ELECTED OFFICIALS.** The elected officials of the City shall be the Mayor and four Alderpersons.
 - (b) **ALDERPERSONS.** A total of four alderpersons shall be elected by and from the residents of the City. Each elected alderperson shall be an at-large alderperson representing the entire constituency of the City of Shullsburg. Each alderperson shall serve for a term of 2 years commencing on the third Tuesday of April in the year of his or her election. Alderpersons currently in office at the passage of this ordinance shall continue to serve for the duration of their elected term.
 - (c) FIRST YEAR IMPLEMENTAION OF CHARTER ORDINANCE. For proper implementation of this charter ordinance, the two regularly scheduled aldermanic elections in 2020 shall be for one year terms. The initial election for at large seats shall be the 2021 Spring Election. The two candidates receiving the most votes shall receive two-year terms. The two candidates receiving the next highest number of votes shall receive one-year terms. Successive elections shall be for at-large seats for two-year terms.
- 3. **Severability.** If any portion of this Ordinance or its application on any person or circumstances is held invalid, the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any other provision herein or its application shall not be affected.
- 4. **Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall take effect 60 days following its passage by two-thirds vote of the members-elect of the City Council and publication as a Class 1 Notice.
