AUTHORIZATION APPROVING ALTERATION OF COUNTY BOARD SUPERVISORY DISTRICTS 7 AND 8 PURSUANT TO CITY OF RIVER FALLS ANNEXATION OF PROPERTY IN THE TOWN OF RIVER FALLS

WHEREAS, in 2021 the Pierce County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance 21-05 and a 10-year supervisory district plan creating county supervisory districts as part of the redistricting process following the 2020 Census; and

WHEREAS, Sec. 59.10(3)(c) Wis. Stats. allows a county board, in its discretion, to alter boundaries of supervisory districts to reflect a municipal annexation that occurs after the adoption of the 10-year plan, as long as the number of supervisory districts in the County does not change; and

WHEREAS, the City of River Falls completed an annexation from the Town of River Falls on April 9, 2024 of the parcels described in City of River Falls Ordinance 24-01, consisting of approximately 22.659 acres; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance of the annexed parcels, along with a map, has been filed with the Pierce County Clerk's Office and are attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the parcels annexed by the City of River Falls are part of County Board Supervisory District #8; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to move the annexed parcels from County Supervisor District #8 into County Supervisor District #7, in Ward #14 in the City of River Falls; and

WHEREAS, the parcels annexed by the City of River Falls and made part of Ward #14 do not cross an assembly district or congressional district line; and

WHEREAS, the population of the annex parcels is two (2); and

WHEREAS, this resolution does not change the number of supervisory districts in the County.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Pierce County Board of Supervisors that supervisory district boundaries #7 and #8, as set forth in Section 4-1 and The Table of District Descriptions of the Pierce County Code, are hereby altered by moving the annexed parcels described herein from County Supervisor District #8 into County Supervisor District #7, in Ward #14 in the City of River Falls, as shown in the attached documentation.

Requesting Agency: County Clerk, Corporation Counsel

Background: In 2021 the Pierce County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance 21-05 and a 10-year supervisory district plan creating county supervisory districts as part of the redistricting process following the 2020 decennial census. Subsequently, on April 9, 2024, the City of River Falls completed an annexation from the Town of River Falls of two parcels described in City of River Falls Ordinance 24-01, consisting of approximately 22.659 acres. For both parcels of the annexed property, the population totals two people. The parcels annexed by the City of River Falls are part of County Board Supervisory District #8. The City of River Falls is requesting that the annexed property be made part of City of River Falls Ward #14, and County Supervisory District #7. More specifically, the City is requesting that the Pierce County Board of Supervisors exercise its redistricting powers under Sec. 59.10(3)(c) Wis. Stats., to alter the current supervisory boundaries. Pursuant to Sec. 59.10(3)(c) Wis. Stats., after the enactment of a plan of supervisory districts in accordance with the decennial census and redistricting process, the board may amend that plan and alter boundaries to reflect a municipal annexation that occurs between decennial censuses. The number of supervisory districts shall not be changed pursuant to this action.

The action requested is controlled by Secs. 59.10(3)(c) and 5.15 Wis. Stats. Under these statutes, the municipality annexing the property may add the annexed property to an existing, contiguous ward only if the annexed property is in the same county supervisory, assembly or congressional districts* as the ward to which it is added. If the supervisory districts in the annexed territory are different from the districts in the ward to which the property is contiguous, a new ward must be created for the annexed property unless the county board adopts legislation altering is supervisory district boundaries, moving the annexed property into the same supervisory district as the property to which it is annexed, because a single ward may not be located in two or more supervisory districts. Only a county has the authority to redraw its county supervisory district boundaries between decennial redistricting to move residents from one county supervisory district to another. [*If the annexed property is in an assembly district or congressional district different from the assembly or congressional districts in which the existing ward is located, a new ward must be created, no exceptions].

In summary, the County Board has two options to consider, namely altering the county board supervisory boundaries as requested, or refusing to change the boundaries which would force the City of River Falls to create a new city ward for the annexed property.

This resolution alters the supervisory district boundaries by moving the annexed parcels of land from County Board Supervisory District #8 to District #7.

NOTE: In the instant case, the language of the County Code, Section 4.1 describing the supervisory districts is already adequate to incorporate the annexation, and thus does not need to be changed, and therefore an ordinance amending Section 4.1 is not necessary, and rather this Resolution is sufficient to authorize and acknowledge the change.

<u>Staff Recommendation:</u> Approve the Resolution to alter the county board supervisory districts in accordance with the request and supporting documentation.

CITY OF RIVER FALLS ORDINANCE NO. 2024-01

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY OF THE TOWN OF RIVER FALLS TO THE CITY OF RIVER FALLS, WISCONSIN

RECITALS

- A. On January 16, 2024, a petition for annexation via unanimous approval, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, was filed with the City Clerk of the City of River Falls seeking to annex the territory legally described the attached Exhibit B (the "Territory") to the City of River Falls, Wisconsin from the Town of River Falls, Pierce County, Wisconsin pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 66.0217(2).
 - B. A copy of the petition was filed with the Town Clerk of the Town of River Falls.
 - C. Two electors currently reside within the Territory, both of which signed the petition.
- D. The City's Comprehensive Plan designates the Future Land Use classification of the Territory as Medium Density Residential.
- E. The City's Common Council has referred the annexation for Plan Commission review and recommendation back to Common Council.
- F. The City's Plan Commission has recommended a zoning classification of the Territory as R-2 Multiple Family (Medium Density) Residence District.

ORDINANCE

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 66.0217(2), the Common Council of the City of River Falls, St. Croix County and Pierce County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

- 1. Territory Annexed. The Territory is annexed to the City of River Falls.
- 2. <u>Scale Map</u>. The scale map, attached as Exhibit B, shows the Territory to be annexed and its relationship to the boundaries of the City of River Falls and the Town of River Falls.
- 3. <u>Effect of Annexation</u>. From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, the Territory shall be a part of the City of River Falls for any and all purposes provided by law, and all persons coming or residing within such Territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules, and regulations governing the City of River Falls.
- 4. <u>Ward Designation</u>. Upon the effective date of this Ordinance the Territory shall be part of Ward No. 14 in the City of River Falls.

- 5. <u>Clerk Duties</u>. The City Clerk is directed to file and record copies of this Ordinance as required by statute.
- 6. <u>Payment to Town of River Falls</u>. Pursuant to section 66.0217(14)(a)1. of the Wisconsin Statutes, the City agrees to pay the Town of River Falls for five years an amount equal to the amount of property taxes that the Town of River Falls levied on the Territory, as shown by the tax roll prepared under Wis. Stat. § 70.65, in the year in which the annexation of the Territory is final.
- 7. <u>Future Land Use Classification</u>. The Territory has a Future Land Use classification of Medium Density Residential.
- 8. <u>Zoning</u>. Upon recommendation of the Plan Commission per Wis. Stat. § 66.0217(8)(a), the Territory is assigned a zoning classification of R-2 Multiple Family (Medium Density) Residence District.
- 9. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.
 - 10. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication.

The above and foregoing Ordinance was duly adopted by the Common Council of the City of River Falls at a meeting held on April 9, 2024, by a two-thirds vote of the elected members of the Common Council.


