Ordinance No. 1500

AN ORDINANCE DETACHING A PORTION OF LAND FROM THE CITY OF HARTFORD TO THE TOWN OF HARTFORD <u>Tax Key Number 36-1403-001-001</u>

The Common Council of the City of Hartford, Washington/Dodge Counties, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: TERRITORY DETACHED. On December 6, 2024, the City of Hartford received a NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CIRCULATE A PETITION OF DETACHMENT/CITY OF HARTFORD, WASHINGTON COUNTY, WISCONSIN from the City of Hartford, the property owner, stating that they will petition the City of Hartford and the Town of Hartford for an Order to detach the following described real estate from the City of Hartford and it will then become a part of the Town of Hartford (See Exhibit A):

That part of the South Half of the Southwest Quarter (S \checkmark SW \bigstar) of Section Fourteen (14), Township Ten (10) North, Range Eighteen (18) East, Washington County, Wisconsin, described as follows, viz:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of said Section 14; thence North 89 degrees 58 minutes 45 seconds East, 278.24 feet to a point on the Southerly right-of-way line of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul & Pacific Railroad Company and the point of beginning of this description; thence North 73 degrees 24 minutes 28 seconds East, along said right-of-way, 2237.41 feet to a point; thence South 00 degrees 01 minutes 15 seconds East, 638.13 feet to a point; thence South 89 degrees 58 minutes 45 seconds West, 2144.48 feet to the point of beginning of this parcel

Contains 15.71 acres more or less.

SECTION 2: The subject parcel is identified by tax key number 36-1403-001-001.

SECTION 3: The subject parcel is an interior parcel located North of E. Sumner Street, South and East of Hilldale Road and South along the Wisconsin and Southern Railroad line, and West of Kettle Moraine Road.

SECTION 4: The subject parcel is owned in its entirety by the City of Hartford and the population of that territory is zero (0).

SECTION 5: On December 9, 2024, the City of Hartford received a Petition from the City of Hartford, pursuant to Wis. Stats. s.66.0227(1), petitioning the City of Hartford 'to detach said property from the City of Hartford and it will then become a part of the Town of Hartford.

SECTION 6: On January 13, 2025, the City of Hartford Plan Commission recommended that the subject property be detached.

SECTION 7: Pursuant to Wis. Stats. s.66.0227(2), the City of Hartford Common Council is authorized to adopt an ordinance approving the detachment, rejecting the detachment or approving the detachment subject to conditions.

SECTION 8: The City of Hartford finds that it is in the interest of the City of Hartford to permit detachment of the Subject Property as follows:

The City of Hartford hereby approves the detachment of the Subject Property as described in SECTION 1 and Exhibit A.

Except as specifically modified and amended by this ordinance, the Municipal Code of the City of Hartford shall remain in force and effect as originally adopted and previously amended. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in contravention of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

If a court of competent jurisdiction adjudges any section, clause, provision or portion of the ordinance unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 9: Upon its adoption, a copy of this City Ordinance # <u>So</u> shall be forwarded to the Town of Hartford Clerk for the Town's enactment of an associated attachment ordinance pursuant to Wis. Stats. s.66.0227(2), to accept the terms of this detachment ordinance within 60 days after the City ordinance's enactment. The failure of the Town of Hartford to enact an attachment ordinance within that 60 days is a rejection of the petition and all proceedings are void.

SECTION 10: Effective Date. This detachment ordinance $\#_{1500}$ shall take effect upon the date of the enactment of an associated attachment ordinance by the Town of Hartford or other stated "Effective Date" therein, accepting the detached territory within 60 days after this City detachment ordinance's adoption.

AN ORDINANCE ATTACHING A PORTION OF LAND FROM THE CITY OF HARTFORD TO THE TOWN OF HARTFORD

City of Hartford Tax Key Number 36-1403-001-001

The Town Board of the Town of Hartford (the "Town"), Washington County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

WHEREAS the City of Hartford (the "City") owns a parcel of land with that has the Tax Key number 36-1403-001-001 and that is more particularly described as:

That part of the South Half of the Southwest Quarter (S ½ SW ¼) of Section Fourteen (14), Township Ten (10) North, Range Eighteen (18) East, Wahington County, Wisconsin, described as follows, viz:

Commencing at the southwest corner of said Section 14; thence North 89 degrees 58 minutes 45 seconds East, 278.24 feet to a point on the Southerly right-of-way line of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul & Pacific Railroad Company and the point of beginning of this description; thence North 73 degrees 24 minutes 28 seconds East, along said right-of-way, 2237.41 feet to a point; thence South 00 degrees 01 minutes 15 seconds East, 638.13 feet to a point; thence South 89 degrees 58 minutes 45 seconds West, 2144.48 feet to the point of beginning of this parcel.

Contains 15.71 acres more or less, and

(the above-described land will be referred to as the "Property" throughout this ordinance).

WHEREAS, on December 6, 2024, the City published a Notice of Intent to Circulate a Petition of Detachment on December 6, 2024; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wis. Stat § 66.0227(1), on or about December 6, 2024, the City filed a petition to detach the Property from the City and attach the Property to the Town; and

WHEREAS no electors or other population are residing in the Property to be detached; and

WHEREAS the Property abuts the Town on all sides; and

WHEREAS the City's Plan Commission recommended that the Property be detached; and

WHEREAS pursuant to Wis, Stat. § 66.0227 (2), the City's Common Council authorized the detachment of the Property and the Town's enactment of an associated attachment ordinance accepting the detached territory within 60 days after the City's detachment ordinance's enactment; and

Town Ordinance, 36-1403-001-001 Detachment

WHEREAS the requirements of Wis Stat. § 66.0227 have been fully complied with, and the detachment/attachment is in the best interest of both the City and the Town;

NOW, THEREFORE, The Town Board of the Town of Hartford does ordain as follows:

PART I: The temporary zoning of the Property is Agricultural Transition, subject to a future amendment to the Town's Zoning Map after a future public hearing.

PART II: The Property described in the first Whereas statement above is hereby attached to the Town of Hartford pursuant to Wis. Stats. §66.0227(2) and shall be part of Town of Hartford – Ward 4.

PART III: The official Town map is hereby amended to include the Property. All persons coming within such property shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the Town of Hartford.

PART IV: If any section or portion of this ordinance shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

PART V: The provisions of this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.

PART VI: Effective Date: This attachment ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Town of Hartford, accepting the detached territory from the City of Hartford as required within 60 days after the City's detachment ordinance's adoption.
