TO THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OSHKOSH, WINNEBAGO COUNTY, WISCONSIN:

WHEREAS, the undersigned constituting all of the electors and all of the owners of real property in the territory proposed to be annexed;

NOW, THEREFORE, PETITION IS HEREBY MADE by unanimous approval pursuant to the provisions of Sec. 66.0217(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes, for direct annexation to the City of Oshkosh, Wisconsin, from the Town of Oshkosh, Winnebago County, Wisconsin, of the real estate hereinafter described.



Subject: JENNERMAN ANNEXATION

Section 66.0217 (6), Wis. Stats., provides that the annexation of lands to cities and villages within a county having a population of 50,000 or more shall be reviewed by the Department of Administration in order to determine if the proposed annexation is in the public interest or against the public interest. The proposed annexation from the Town of Oshkosh to the City of Oshkosh (see attached description) must be reviewed pursuant to the statute.

To assist us in making this determination, we urge that you promptly supply the data requested on the enclosed questionnaire (where possible) and return the questionnaire to the department.

The purpose of this questionnaire is to assist the department in determining "Whether the governmental services, including zoning, to be supplied to the territory could clearly be better supplied by the town...."

The statute further stipulates that the department shall study the "shape of the proposed annexation and the homogeneity of the territory with the annexing municipality." In addition, we would appreciate receiving from you any comments or information bearing on governmental services or shape and homogeneity that would indicate whether the annexation is in or against the public interest.

Our reply must be prepared within a very limited statutory deadline. Please return the questionnaire no later than June 25, 2004 so that the information can be reviewed prior to the department's statutory deadline of June 30, 2004. Direct any questions and comments to Erich Schmidtke at (608) 264-6102 or to me at (608) 266-0683. Thank you for your cooperation.

Enclosed please also find 2003 Wisconsin Act 317 that makes a number of changes to annexation law. In order for this annexation petition to be considered for adoption as an ordinance, the proposed annexation will be need to comply with this law.

The proposed annexation submitted to our office on June 10, 2004, has been reviewed and found to be in the public interest.

The Department reminds clerks of annexing municipalities of the requirements of s. 66.0217 (9)(a), Wis. Stats., which states:

"The clerk of a city or village which has annexed shall file immediately with the secretary of state a certified copy of the ordinance, certificate and plat, and shall send one copy to each company that provides any utility service in the area that is annexed. The clerk shall record the ordinance with the register of deeds and file a signed copy of the ordinance with the clerk of any affected school district..."

State and federal aids based on population and equalized value may be significantly affected through failure to file with the Secretary of State. Please file a copy of your annexing ordinance, including a statement certifying the population of the annexed territory. The address of the Office of the Secretary of State is:
