## Resolution No.:32-25

## **Amending Supervisory District Boundaries to Reflect Annexations**

A Resolution Amending the County Supervisory District Map for Districts 8 & 11 to reflect Annexation by the Town of Elk.

**WHEREAS**, the Price County Board of Supervisors adopted the current Supervisory District Boundaries in November of 2021, via Ordinance 2021-01; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Elk annexed a portion of the City of Phillips on December 11, 2024; and recorded it with the Price County Register of Deeds on June 26, 2025; and,

**WHEREAS**, Wisconsin statute section 59 .10(3)( c) allows the Price County Board of Supervisors to amend supervisory districts to reflect city, village and town incorporation, annexation, detachment, or consolidation which has occurred since its last adoption or amendment of supervisory districts and to make such adjustments to supervisory district boundaries as may be appropriate for purposes of election administration; and,

WHEREAS, a common practice is for cities, villages, and towns to assign the area being annexed to the adjacent ward within their corporate limits and for the Price County Board to amend supervisory district boundaries to match the new corporate limits. This resolution amends the supervisory district boundaries to reflect the annexations that have occurred since the Price County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance Number 2021-01; and,

WHEREAS, the Price County Redistricting Committee, under direction of the Price County Executive Committee, considered this ordinance on October 9, 2025, and recommended that the Price County Board of Supervisors approve amending the boundaries of Supervisory Districts 8 & 11 to move the annexed parcel from Supervisory District 11, representing the City of Phillips, to Supervisory District 8, representing the Town of Elk; and,

WHEREAS, there is a population of 3 in the annexed parcel; and,

**WHEREAS**, if not approved, a new voting ward would have to be created, and ballots printed, for a ward that has a population of 3.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Price County Board of Supervisors hereby amends the Supervisory District Maps to transfer the following real property from Supervisory District 11 to Supervisory District 8:

## Ordinance 2021 - 01

## An Ordinance to Amend the Code of the County of Price, Chapter 191 Thereof, Entitled "Board of Supervisors", to Change the Composition of the Supervisory Districts

Be it ordained by the Price County Board of Supervisors, as follows:

Section 1. Article II Supervisory Districts, Section 191-5 of Chapter 191, Board of Supervisors, of the Code of the County of Price, is hereby amended to change the Supervisory District composition as follows:

That one supervisor be elected from each district, commencing with the 2022 Spring Election.

That said thirteen supervisory districts be comprised as follows:
