PETITION FOR DIRECT ANNEXATION AND REZONING BY UNANIMOUS APPROVAL PURSUANT TO S. 66.0217(2). WISCONSIN STATUTES

We, the undersigned, constituting all of the owners of the real property in which two electors reside in the following territory of the Town of Seymour, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, lying contiguous to the City of Seymour, petition the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Seymour to annex the territory described below and shown on the attached scale map to the City of Seymour, Outagamie County, Wisconsin:

The current population of such property is two.


The number of electors in such territory is two.

Subject: CITY OF SEYMOUR ANNEXATION

Section 66.0217 (6), Wis. Stats., provides that the annexation of lands to cities and villages within a county having a population of 50,000 or more shall be reviewed by the Department of Administration in order to determine if the proposed annexation is in the public interest or against the public interest. The proposed annexation from the TOWN OF SEYMOUR to the CITY OF SEYMOUR (see attached description) must be reviewed pursuant to the statute.

To assist us in making this determination, we urge that you promptly supply the data requested on the enclosed questionnaire (where possible) and return the questionnaire to the department.

Subject: CITY OF SEYMOUR ANNEXATION

The proposed annexation submitted to our office on September 08, 2015, has been reviewed and found to be in the public interest. In determining whether an annexation is in the public interest, s. 66.0217 (6), Wis. Stats. requires the Department to examine "[t]he shape of the proposed annexation and the homogeneity of the territory with the annexing village or city and any other contiguous village or city...." so as unincorporated land transitions to city or village status, the resulting boundaries are rational and easy for jurisdictions and residents to follow. The subject petition is for territory that is reasonably shaped and contiguous to the CITY OF SEYMOUR.

Notes:

- -The scale map of the area to be annexed must include a graphic scale bar.
- -It appears the map of the area to be annexed includes part of the CTH "G" right-of-way that is not included in the description; please revise the map and/or description so that they are consistent with each other.

"The clerk of a city or village which has annexed shall file immediately with the secretary of state a certified copy of the ordinance, certificate and plat, and shall send one copy to each company that provides any utility service in the area that is annexed. The clerk shall record the ordinance with the register of deeds and file a signed copy of the ordinance with the clerk of any affected school district..."

Please file a copy of your annexing ordinance, including a statement certifying the population of the annexed territory.
