
PRIMARY SCHOOL AREA **ANNEXATION MAP**




These maps are a lot easier to read. The blueish line actually surrounds the area to be annexed.

Chris said sometimes that happens with the program he uses when the maps get opened in another program some of the lines disappear.



The proposed annexation submitted to our office on September 25, 2018, has been reviewed and found to be in the public interest. In determining whether an annexation is in the public interest, s. 66.0217 (6), Wis. Stats. requires the Department to examine "[t]he shape of the proposed annexation and the homogeneity of the territory with the annexing village or city..." so as, to ensure the resulting boundaries are rational and compact. The statute also requires the Department to consider whether the annexing city or village can provide needed municipal services to the territory. The subject petition is for territory that is reasonably shaped and contiguous to the VILLAGE OF WAUNAKEE, which is able to provide needed municipal services.

The Department reminds clerks of annexing municipalities of the requirements of s. 66.0217 (9)(a), Wis. Stats., which states:

"The clerk of a city or village which has annexed shall file immediately with the secretary of administration a certified copy of the ordinance, certificate and plat, and shall send one copy to each company that provides any utility service in the area that is annexed. The clerk shall record the ordinance with the register of deeds and file a signed copy of the ordinance with the clerk of any affected school district..."

Please file a copy of your annexing ordinance, including a statement certifying the population of the annexed territory. Please include your MBR number 14157 with your ordinance.
