Subject: GERHARTZ SCENIC MEADOWS LLC ANNEXATION

The proposed annexation submitted to our office on May 17, 2024, has been reviewed and found to be in the public interest. In determining whether an annexation is in the public interest, s. 66.0217 (6), Wis. Stats. requires the Department to examine "[t]he shape of the proposed annexation and the homogeneity of the territory with the annexing village or city...." so as, to ensure the resulting boundaries are rational and compact. The statute also requires the Department to consider whether the annexing city or village can provide needed municipal services to the territory. The subject petition is for territory that is reasonably shaped and contiguous to the City of Fond du Lac, which is able to provide needed municipal services.

Notes: 1) It appears that road right-of-way located in the Town and to the south of the annexation territory needs to be included as part of the annexation for contiguity with the City to exist; 2) The location of the City's existing municipal boundaries should be shown on the scale map, and 3) Fond du Lac County indicates that a portion of the annexation territory may be located within the Empire Sanitary District #3. The District boundaries may need to be altered prior to the annexation being adopted.

The Department reminds clerks of annexing municipalities of the requirements of s. 66.0217 (9)(a), Wis. Stats., which states that the clerk of a city or village which has annexed shall file immediately with the secretary of administration a certified copy of the ordinance, certificate and plat, and shall send one copy to each company that provides any utility service in the area that is annexed. The clerk shall record the ordinance with the register of deeds and file a signed copy of the ordinance with the clerk of any affected school district..." State and federal aids based on population and equalized value may be significantly affected through failure to file with the Department of Administration. Please file a copy of your annexing ordinance, including a statement certifying the population of the annexed territory. Please include your MBR number 14671 with your ordinance.
