PETITION FOR DIRECT ANNEXATION

BY UNANIMOUS APPROVAL

The undersigned hereby petition the Village of Johnson Creek, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, for annexation to the Village of Johnson Creek of the territory contiguous to the Village of Johnson Creek but lying in the Town of Farmington, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, as legally described and depicted on the scale map attached hereto as Exhibit A.

This Petition is for direct annexation by unanimous approval under Wisconsin Statutes Section 66.0217(2). There are no electors residing in the territory to be annexed (according to the Wisconsin Elections Commission website, www.myvote.wi.gov). The signatory of this Petition represents all of the owners of the land within the territory to be annexed. The population of the total territory to be annexed, based on representations from Petition signers, is estimated to be zero (0) electors.

The purpose of the annexation is to expand the Village's growth area, to make Village of Johnson Creek services available to the territory and to ready the territory for future development. 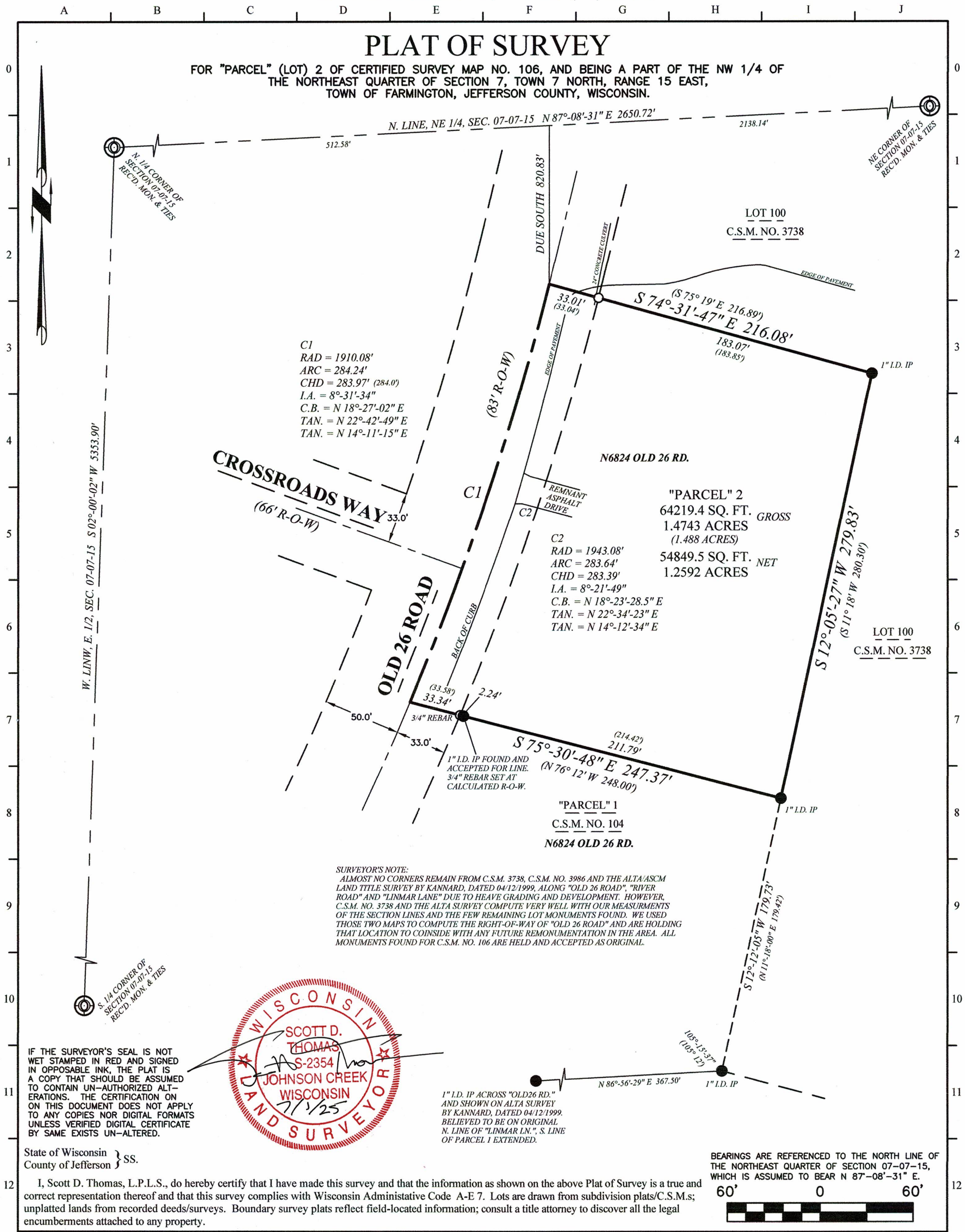

Subject: NELSON ANNEXATION

The proposed annexation submitted to our office on July 31, 2025, has been reviewed and found to be in the public interest. In determining whether an annexation is in the public interest, s. 66.0217 (6), Wis. Stats. requires the Department to examine "[t]he shape of the proposed annexation and the homogeneity of the territory with the annexing village or city..." so as, to ensure the resulting boundaries are rational and compact. The statute also requires the Department to consider whether the annexing city or village can provide needed municipal services to the territory. The subject petition is for territory that is reasonably shaped and contiguous to the Village of Johnson Creek, which is able to provide needed municipal services.

Note: The scale map of the territory to be annexed must clearly show and identify the existing Village of Johnson Creek municipal boundary.

The Department reminds clerks of annexing municipalities of the requirements of s. 66.0217 (9)(a), Wis. Stats., which states:

"The clerk of a city or village which has annexed shall file immediately with the secretary of administration a certified copy of the ordinance, certificate and plat, and shall send one copy to each company that provides any utility service in the area that is annexed. The clerk shall record the ordinance with the register of deeds and file a signed copy of the ordinance with the clerk of any affected school district..."

State and federal aids based on population and equalized value may be significantly affected through failure to file with the Department of Administration. Please file a copy of your annexing ordinance, including a statement certifying the population of the annexed territory. **Please include your MBR number 14783 with your ordinance.** Ordinance filing checklist available at <http://mds.wi.gov/>, click on "Help on How to Submit Municipal Records". 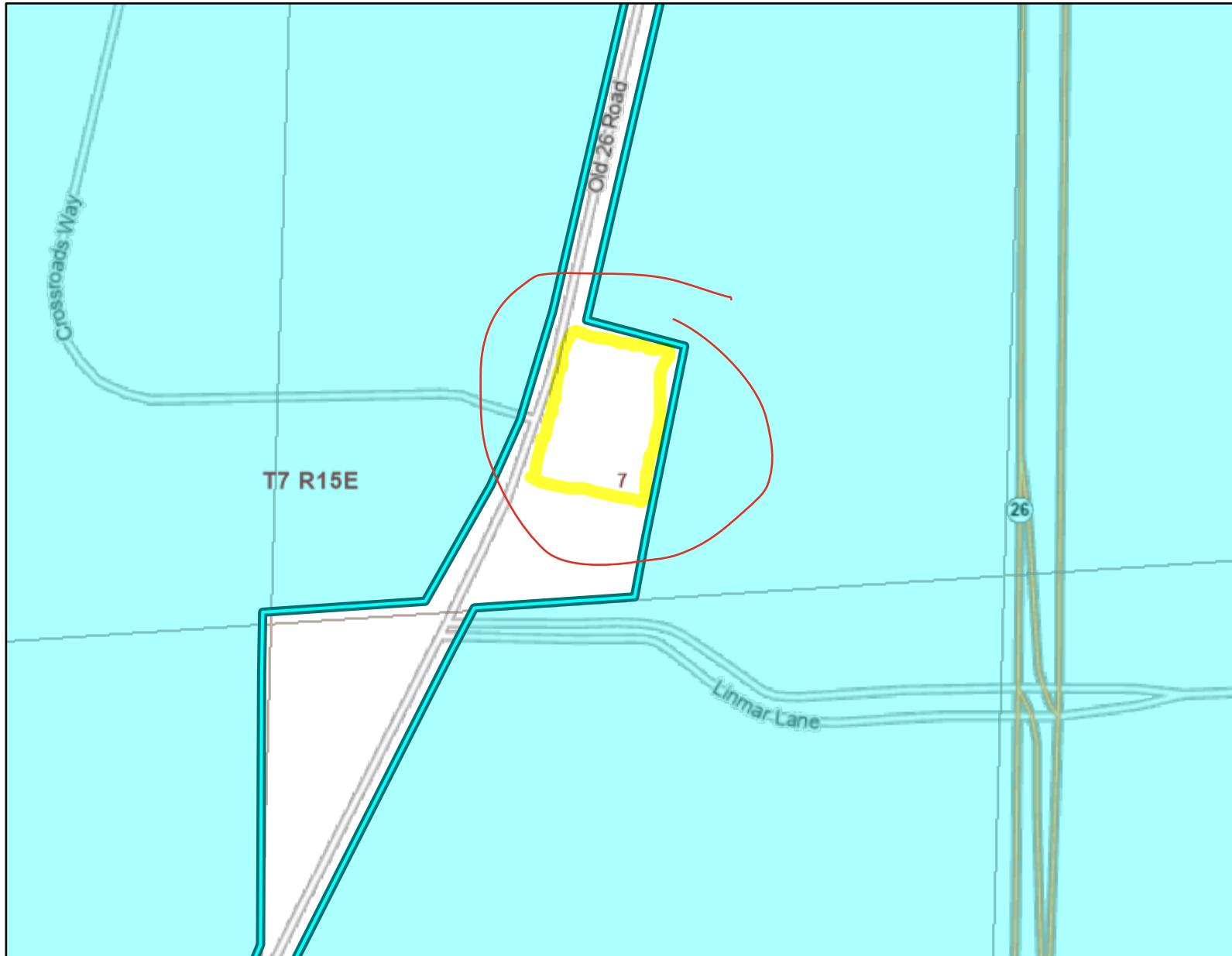
