Re: Seventh Petition for Direct Annexation by Unanimous Approval

I previously sent to you various documents in connection with the Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Annexations and, together with this letter, documents in connection with the Sixth Annexation, of approximately 204 acres of territory, 457 acres of territory, 67.85 acres of territory, 24 acres of territory and 332 acres of territory, respectively, located in the Town of Port Washington, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin contiguous at the north to the current City of Port Washington, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin boundary, of which the Second through Fifth Petitions are now being processed as MBR File Nos. 14769, 14770, 14771 and 14777, respectively, and will be considered by the City of Port Washington Common Council on August 19, 2025. If those 204, 457, 67.85, 24 and 332 acres are annexed, owners and electors desire to annex an additional approximately 59.28 acres of territory in the Town of Port Washington, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin Statutes Section 66.0217(2) and will be consistent with the Supplemental Agreement between the City and Town of Port Washington. This Seventh Annexation will be in the public interest for the same reasons that MBR File Nos. 14753, 14769, 14770, 14771 and 14777 are in the public interest.

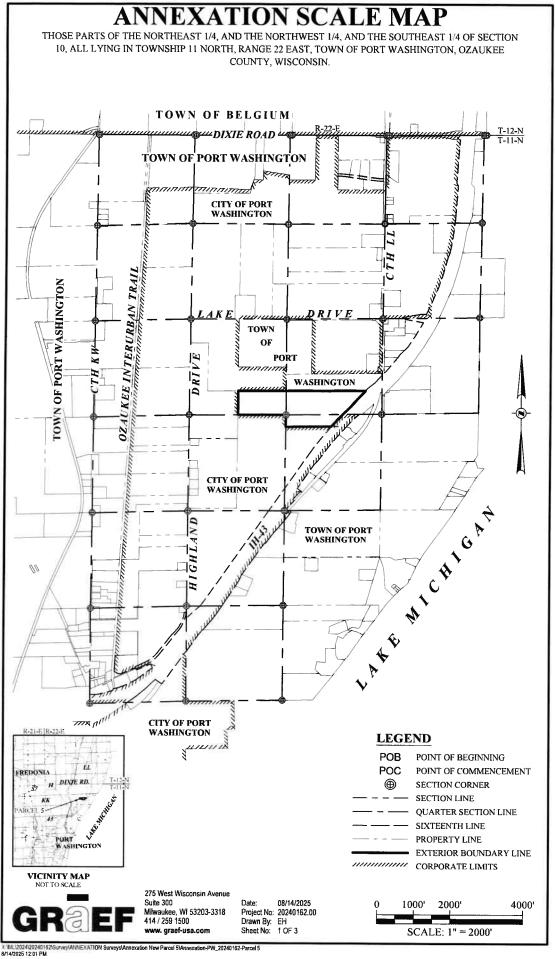

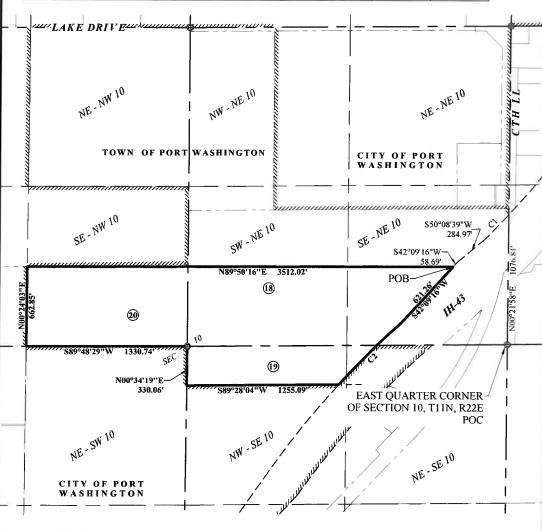

### PETITION FOR DIRECT ANNEXATION BY UNANIMOUS APPROVAL

The proposed annexation submitted to our office on August 15, 2025, has been reviewed and found to be in the public interest. In determining whether an annexation is in the public interest, s. 66.0217 (6), Wis. Stats. requires the Department to examine "[t]he shape of the proposed annexation and the homogeneity of the territory with the annexing village or city...." so as, to ensure the resulting boundaries are rational and compact. The statute also requires the Department to consider whether the annexing city or village can provide needed municipal services to the territory. The subject petition is for territory that is reasonably shaped and contiguous to the City of Port Washington, which is able to provide needed municipal services.

Note: It appears that the legal description call to the west line of the said NW ¼ (of Section 10) should be to the west line of the SE ¼ of said NW ¼.

The Department reminds clerks of annexing municipalities of the requirements of s. 66.0217 (9)(a), Wis. Stats., which states:

"The clerk of a city or village which has annexed shall file immediately with the secretary of administration a certified copy of the ordinance, certificate and plat, and shall send one copy to each company that provides any utility service in the area that is annexed. The clerk shall record the ordinance with the register of deeds and file a signed copy of the ordinance with the clerk of any affected school district..."
