CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 8- 2026

**A CHARTER ORDINANCE TO RENAME CHAPTER 2, DIVISION 3 AND
TO REPEAL AND RECREATE SECTIONS 2-163 AND 2-164 OF THE CODE OF
ORDINANCES FOR THE VILLAGE OF UNION GROVE RELATED TO
SEPARATING THE OFFICES OF THE VILLAGE TREASURER AND VILLAGE
FINANCE DIRECTOR AND THE ELIMINATION OF THE OFFICE OF THE
VILLAGE FINANCE DIRECTOR.**

The President and the Trustees of the Village of Union Grove, Racine County, Wisconsin, do herewith ordain as follows:

SECTION I

Pursuant to Sections 61.195 and 66.0101 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Village of Union Grove hereby elects to separate the offices of the Village Treasurer and Village Finance Director that were previously consolidated under Charter Ordinance 2018-20 and to eliminate the office of the Village Finance Director. The Village further elects not to be governed by those provisions of Sections 61.19 and 61.23 of the Wisconsin Statutes that are in conflict with this ordinance.

SECTION II

1. That Chapter 2, Division 3 be renamed as follows:

“Division 3. Village Clerk and Village Treasurer”.

2. That Section 2-163 of the Village of Union Grove Municipal Code of Ordinances pertaining to Village Finance Director/Treasurer is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

“Sec. 2-163. Village Treasurer; appointment and term of office.

The Village Treasurer shall be appointed by the Village Board. The appointed Village Treasurer shall hold office for an indefinite term, subject to removal as provided in Section 17.13 of the Wisconsin Statutes.”

3. That Section 2-164 of the Village of Union Grove Municipal Code of Ordinances pertaining to Village Finance Director/Treasurer is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

“Sec. 2-164. Village Treasurer; duties.

The Village Treasurer shall have all powers, duties, and authority of the office of Village Treasurer as provided by Wis. Stat. § 61.26 and those other duties as the Village Board or Village Administrator directs to be executed from time-to-time.”

Section III



All ordinances in conflict with any of the provisions of this Charter Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section IV

This Charter Ordinance shall take effect sixty (60) days after its passage and publication unless within such sixty (60) day period a referendum petition as provided by Section 66.0101(5) of the Wisconsin Statutes shall be filed, in which event this ordinance shall not take effect until it shall have been submitted to a referendum vote of the electors and approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

This Charter Ordinance was approved by at least a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Village Board on this 27 day of July, 2026.

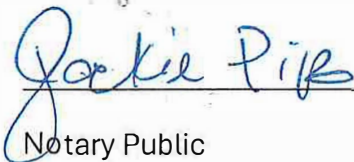

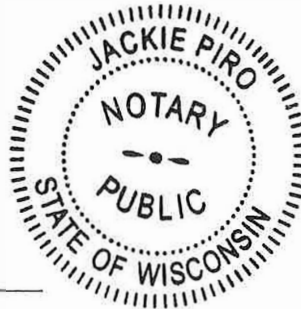

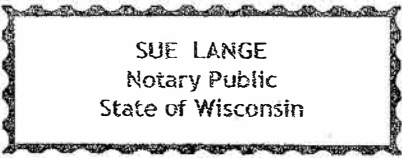
