ORDINANCE NO. 666

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 9 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE  
PERTAINING TO NOISES

The Village Board of the Village of Greendale does  
ordain as follows:

PART 1. Section 9.06(1) is hereby repealed and recreated to  
read as follows:

SECTION 9.06. NOISES PROHIBITED.

(1) No person shall make, continue or cause to made  
or continued any excessive, unnecessary or  
unusually loud noise or any noise which  
unreasonably either annoys, disturbs, injures  
or endangers the comfort, repose, health, peace  
or safety of others within the limits of the  
Village.

PART 2. Section 9.06(2)(b) shall be repealed and recreated  
to read as follows:

(b) Radios, Phonographs, Etc.

The using, operating or permitting to be used,  
played or operated any radio, receiving set,  
musical instrument, phonograph or other machine  
or device for the producing or reproducing of  
sound in such a manner as to unreasonably  
disturb the peace, quiet and comfort of the  
neighboring inhabitants or, at any time, with  
louder volume than is reasonably necessary for  
the convenient hearing for the person or  
persons who are in the room, vehicle or area in  
which such machine or device is operated and  
who are voluntary listeners thereto. The  
operation of any such set, instrument,  
phonograph, machine or device in such manner as  
to be plainly audible at a distance of fifty  
(50) feet from the building, structure or  
vehicle in which it is located shall be prima-  
facie evidence of a violation of this section.



PART 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
