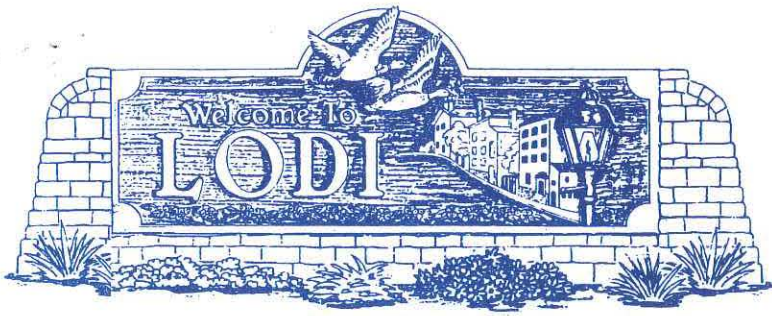

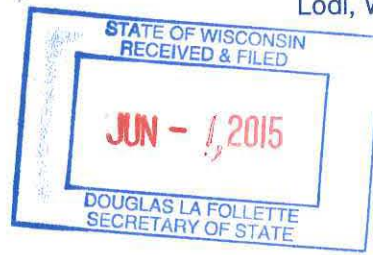

ORDINANCE NUMBER 5, S-110

A CHARTER ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE STRUCTURE OF THE CITY OF LODI UTILITIES COMMISSION, THE LENGTH AND COMMENCEMENT DATE OF TERMS FOR MEMBERS OF THE UTILITIES COMMISSION

The Common Council of the City of Lodi, Columbia County do ordain a Charter Ordinance as follows:

Section 1.

The City of Lodi pursuant to Chapter 66.0101 Wisc. Stats. hereby elects not to be governed by Chapter 66.085(1) and 66.085(2) Wisc. Stats. relating to the management of City of Lodi Utilities, the number of commissioners and the commence date of their terms to the extent of any that such sections may be in conflict with this charter ordinance. This Charter Ordinance creates power by City Charter to amend sections of the City Charter to the extent, if any that such sections may be in conflict with this Charter Ordinance.

Section 2.

Commencing in April 2015 the appointment and terms of office for members of the Utilities Commissions shall be as found in Chapter 12 Boards, Commissions and Committees of the Code of the City of Lodi, Section 12-7 Utility Commission, as follows:

Utility Commission. The Utility Commission shall consist of seven (7) members. One (1) member shall be an Alderperson who shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the Common Council for a term of one-year commencing on May 1. The remaining six (6) members of the Commission shall serve a three-year term commencing May 1. The terms shall be staggered so that no more than two (2) members' terms shall expire each year. Members shall be appointed by the Mayor with the powers and responsibilities prescribed by Wisconsin State Statute and the Code of the City of Lodi.

Section 3.

This charter ordinance shall take effect sixty (60) days after its adoption and publication unless within such sixty (60) days a referendum petition shall be filled as provided by Chapter 66.0101 Wisc. Stats, in which event this Charter Ordinance shall not take effect until submitted to a referendum and approved by a majority of electors voting thereon, as provided by Chapter 66.0101 Wisc. Stats.

Adopted by the Common Council of the City of Lodi, Wisconsin, this 6th day of January, 2015 on a roll call vote: Schultz-aye, Ness-aye, Tonn-aye, Welch-aye, Stevenson-aye.
