

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



AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING THE ROBERT AND BRENDA DANIELS PROPERTY, 2007 SHOPIERE ROAD, TO THE CITY OF BELOIT

The City Council of the City of Beloit, Rock County, Wisconsin does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. In accordance with Section 66.021(12) of the Wisconsin Statutes and the petition for direct annexation filed with the City Clerk on the 19th day of May, 2000, signed by all of the owners of real property and all the electors residing in the following described property in the Town of Turtle, Rock County, Wisconsin, the following is annexed to the City of Beloit, Wisconsin:

Lot 10 of Block 8 of Lindale Place and a portion of Shopiere Road (CTH "S") being a part of the Southwest ¼ of Section 19, Township 1 North, Range 13 East of the 4th P.M. Rock County, Wisconsin. Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Lot 10; thence Southeasterly, 155 feet to the centerline of said Shopiere Road; thence Southwesterly, 50 feet along said centerline; thence Northwesterly, 155 feet to the Northwest corner of said Lot 10; thence Northeasterly, 50 feet to the point of beginning. (commonly known as: 2007 Shopiere Road)

Section 2. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this ordinance the territory described in Section 1 shall be part of the City of Beloit for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules, and regulations governing the City of Beloit.

Section 3. Temporary Zoning Classification. A) Upon recommendation of the Plan Commission the territory annexed to the City of Beloit by this ordinance is temporarily designated to be part of the following district of the City for zoning purposes and subject to all provisions of Chapter 19 of the Code of General Ordinances of the City of Beloit, entitled "The City of Beloit Zoning Ordinance" relating to such district classifications and to zoning in the City: R-1B, Single-family Residential District. B) The boundaries of these designated districts are established as shown on the map filed in the office of the City Clerk. C) The Plan Commission is directed to initiate an amendment to the zoning ordinance not later than 30 days from the effective date of this ordinance setting forth a permanent classification and regulations for the zoning of the annexed area and to submit its recommendations to the City Council.

Section 4. Ward Designation. The territories described in Section 1 of this ordinance are hereby made a part of the 22nd Ward of the City of Beloit, subject to the ordinances, rules, and regulations of the City, governing ward districts.

Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon its passage and publication.


