CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 6 A-514

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL SECTION 49-1 AND REPEAL AND RECREATE SECTION 78-2B OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES

The Common Council of the City of Lodi, Columbia County, Wisconsin does hereby ordain as follows:

- 1. Section 49-1, Wards, is hereby repealed in its entirety.
- 2. Section 78-2B Elected Officials is repealed and recreated to now read as follows:
 - B. Alderpersons. A total of six alderpersons shall be elected by and from the residents of the City. Each elected alderperson shall be an at-large alderperson representing the entire constituency of the City of Lodi. Each alderperson shall serve for a term of 2 years commencing on the third Tuesday of April in the year of his or her election. Alderpersons elected in odd-numbered years as of the effective date of this Ordinance shall continue to be elected in odd years. Alderpersons elected in even-numbered years as of the effective date of this Ordinance shall continue to be elected in effective date of this Ordinance shall continue to be elected in even-numbered years.
- 3. **Severability.** If any portion of this Ordinance or its application on any person or circumstances is held invalid, the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any other provision herein or its application shall not be affected.
- 4. **Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall take effect 60 days following its passage by two-thirds vote of the members-elect of the City Council and publication as a Class 1 Notice.
