



The Common Council of the City of Appleton does ordain as follows:

Section 1. <u>Territory Annexed</u>. In accordance with Sec. 66.021 of the <u>Wisconsin Statutes for 1997-98</u> and the <u>Unanimous Petition for Direct Annexation</u> filed with the City Clerk on September 18, 2000, the following described territory in the Town of Grand Chute, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, lying contiguous to the City of Appleton, is hereby annexed to the City of Appleton, Wisconsin:

Part of the SE and SW quarters of the fractional SW ½ of Section 7, T21N, R18E, Town of Grand Chute, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, described as follows: Commencing at the SW ¼, Section 7, thence S87°-31'-44"E 442.80 feet along the south line of said fractional SW ¼; thence N00°-02'-21"W 33.03 feet to the place of beginning; thence continuing N00°-02'-21"W 708.07 feet; thence S88°-18'-17"E 2247.55 feet; thence S00°-15'-21"W 738.38 feet; thence N87°-31'-44"W 2244.87 feet to the place of beginning. Bounding 37.27 acres more or less.

This parcel contains the north 7 feet of the north 40 feet of Evergreen Drive Right of Way, and the Apple Creek Drainage Corridor Right of Way.

The current population of such territory is 1 person.

Section 2. <u>Effect of Annexation</u>. From and after the date of this Ordinance, the territory described in Section 1 shall be a part of the City of Appleton for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the City of Appleton.

The territory described in Sec. 1 of this Ordinance is hereby made a part of the Forty-second (42<sup>nd</sup>) Ward, attached to the Thirteenth (13<sup>th</sup>) Aldermanic District of the City of Appleton, Outagamie County, subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the City governing Wards.

Section 4. Zoning Classification. The territory described in Sec. 1 is hereby zoned as follows, pursuant to Sec. 66.021(7)(a), Stats. and Sec. 23.65(e), Appleton Municipal Code:


Temporary C-O (Temporary Commercial Office District) and Temporary R-1A (Temporary One Family District)
