### ORDINANCE NO. <u>00-06</u> AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF IOLA, WISCONSIN

The Village Board of the Village of Iola, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. **Territory Annexed**. In accordance with sec. 66.021 of the Wisconsin Statutes and the petition for direct annexation filed with the Village Clerk on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2000, signed by all of the owners of real property in the territory, the following described territory in the Town of Iola, Waupaca County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the Village of Iola, Wisconsin:

SECTION 2. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this ordinance the territory described in SECTION 1 shall be a part of the Village of Iola for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the Village of Iola.

SECTION 3. **Severability**. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

Parcel 1 All that part of the West 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 35, Township 24 North, Range 11 East, described as follows: A piece of land commencing at a point in the Section line 2 chains 59 1/2 links North of the Southwest corner of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 35, Township 24 North, Range 11 East; thence South on Section line 4 chains 50 links to Pailroad right of user thence in an Factoria direction along North line 24 North, Range 11 East; thence South on Section line 4 chains 50 links to Railroad right of way; thence in an Easterly direction along North line of Railroad right of way 20 chains 6 1/2 links to a point 13 1/2 links North of the 1/16 section corner in center of the Southwest 1/4 of said Section 35; thence North on the 1/8 line 2 chains 75 links; thence in a Westerly direction parallel with the South line 11 chains; thence at right angles 1 chains theorem in a Northwesterly direction at a parallel of right angles 1 chain; thence in a Northwesterly direction at an angle of right angles 1 chain; thence in a Northwesterly direction at an angle of 152 degrees North 38 degrees West 4 chains 40 links to center of river from thence (following the center of river channel) to place of beginning. Parcel 2 A tract of land situated in the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 35, Township 24 North, Range 11 East, described as follows: Commencing at the Northeast corner of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of said Section 35 and running thence Westerly along the Northerly boundary line of said Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of said Section 35, a distance of 62.3 feet to an iron pin located on the West line of a town road and 30 feet distant Northerly measured at right angles from the center line of the main track of said Iola Branch Railroad, being the point of beginning; thence Southerly along the West line of said town road 60.38 feet to an iron pin being 30 feet distant Southerly measured at right angles from the center line of the main track of said Iola Branch Railroad; thence Southwesterly along a straight line parallel with the Railroad; thence Southwesterly along a straight line parallel with the said center line of said main tract 588.1 feet to an iron pin; thence Northerly on a straight line parallel with the West line of said town road a distance of 60 feet to an iron pin, being 30 feet distant Northerly measured at right angles from the center line of the main track of said measured at right angles from the center line of the main track of said Iola Branch Railroad; thence Northeasterly along a straight line 30 feet distant from and parallel with the aforesaid main track center line 592.9 feet to the place of beginning.
