AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF CUMBERLAND, WISCONSIN.

The Common Council of the City of Cumberland do ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE. Territory Annexed. In accordance with sec. 66.021 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and the petition for direct annexation filed with the City Clerk-Treasurer on June 7, 2000, signed by all of the owners of the territory, the following described territory in the Town of Crystal Lake, Barron County, Wisconsin, in which no persons reside, is annexed to the City of Cumberland, Wisconsin.

The East 10 acres of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 18, Township 35 North of Range 13 West.

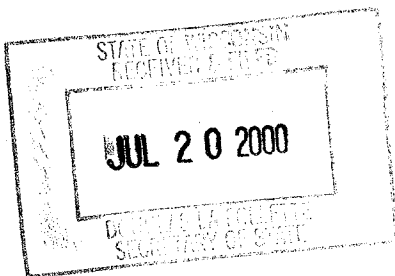
SECTION TWO. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this Ordinance, the territory described in Section One shall be a part of the City of Cumberland for any and all purposes provided by law, and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules, and regulations governing the City of Cumberland.



The Common Council of the City of Cumberland do ordain as follows:


SECTION ONE. Section 1.10(4) of the Municipal Code of the City of Cumberland is hereby created to read as follows:



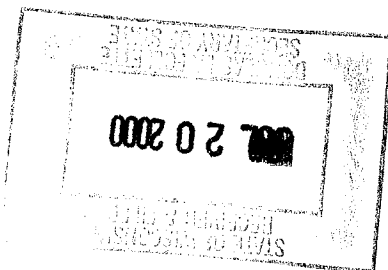

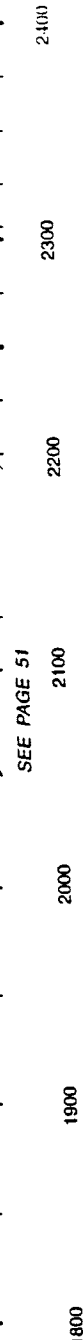
