In accordance with sec. 66.021 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and the petition for direct annexation filed with the City Clerk-Treasurer on June 7, 2000, signed by all of the owners of the territory, the following described territory in the Town of Crystal Lake, Barron County, Wisconsin, in which no persons reside, is annexed to the City of Cumberland, Wisconsin.

The East 10 acres of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 18, Township 35 North of Range 13 West.

SECTION TWO. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this Ordinance, the territory described in Section One shall be a part of the City of Cumberland for any and all purposes provided by law, and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules, and regulations governing the City of Cumberland.

SECTION THREE. Ward Designation. The territory described in Section One of this Ordinance is hereby made a part of the First Ward of the City of Cumberland, subject to the ordinances, rules, and regulations of the City governing wards.

SECTION FOUR. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this Ordinance to any persons or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.




