## AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF APPLETON, WISCONSIN.

(CHRISTOPHER COURT Annexation)

The Common Council of the City of Appleton does ordain as follows:

Section 1. <u>Territory Annexed</u>. In accordance with Sec. 66.021 of the Wisconsin Statutes for 1997-98 and the *Unanimous Petition for Direct Annexation* filed with the City Clerk on June 9, 2000, the following described territory in the Town of Harrison, Calumet County, Wisconsin, lying contiguous to the City of Appleton, is hereby annexed to the City of Appleton, Wisconsin:

All of Lots #2 and #3 of Certified Survey Map No 1665 dated November 23, 1992, revised June 2, 1993 and recorded October 1, 1993, at 3:15 P.M. in Vol 11 of Survey Maps, on page 283 of the Calumet County, Wisconsin Registers Office.

The current population of such territory is 0 people.

Section 2. <u>Effect of Annexation</u>. From and after the date of this Ordinance, the territory described in Section 1 shall be a part of the City of Appleton for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the City of Appleton.

Section 3. Ward Designation. The territory described in Sec. 1 of this Ordinance is hereby made a part of the Tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) Ward, attached to the Fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) Aldermanic District of the City of Appleton, Calumet County, subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the City governing Wards.

Section 4. Zoning Classification. The territory described in Sec. 1 is hereby zoned as follows, pursuant to Sec. 66.021(7)(a), Stats. and Sec. 23.65(e), Appleton Municipal Code:

Temporary R-1A (Temporary Residential One-Family District)

Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance, which can

be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
