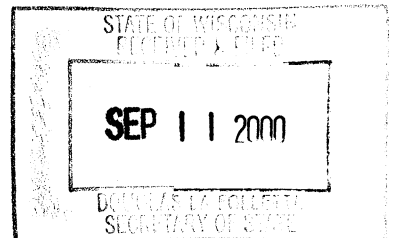

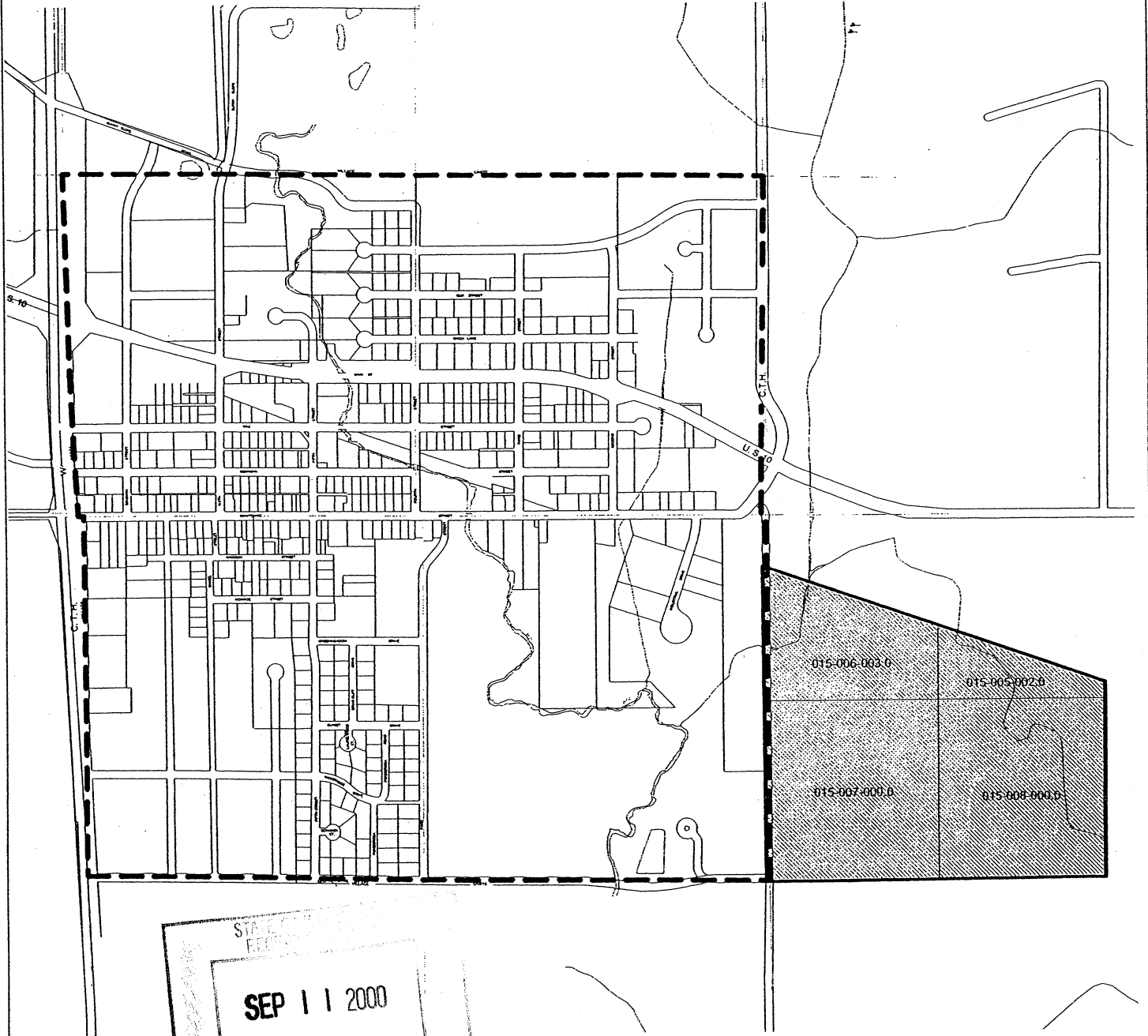

ORDINANCE NO. 5 - 00

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF  
REEDSVILLE, WISCONSIN

The Village Board of the Village of Reedsville, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. TERRITORY ANNEXED. (Direct Annexation) In accordance with sec. 66.021 of the Wisconsin Statutes and the petition for direct annexation filed with the Village Clerk on the 28th day of July, 2000, signed by the owners of all of the land in area and real property in assessed value in the territory, there being no electors residing in the territory, the following described territory in the Town of Rockland, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the Village of Reedsville, Wisconsin:

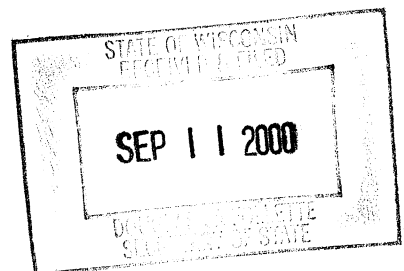
All that part of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Numbered One (1), Township Numbered Nineteen (19) North, Range Numbered Twenty-one (21) East, which lies South of the Chicago & Northwestern Railroad Right-of-Way, in Manitowoc County, Wisconsin.

The population of said territory is zero (0).

SECTION 2. EFFECT OF ANNEXATION. From and after the date of this ordinance the territory described in Section 1 shall be a part of the Village of Reedsville, Wisconsin, for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the Village of Reedsville.

SECTION 3. TEMPORARY ZONING CLASSIFICATION.

(a) Upon recommendation of the Plan Commission, the territory annexed to the Village of Reedsville, Wisconsin, by this ordinance is temporarily zoned as follows, pursuant to sec. 66.021(7)(a), Wis. Stats., as Industrial.



(b) The Plan Commission is directed to prepare an amendment to the zoning ordinance setting forth permanent classifications and regulations for the zoning of the annexed area and to submit its recommendations to the Village Board in a timely manner.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance is found to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
